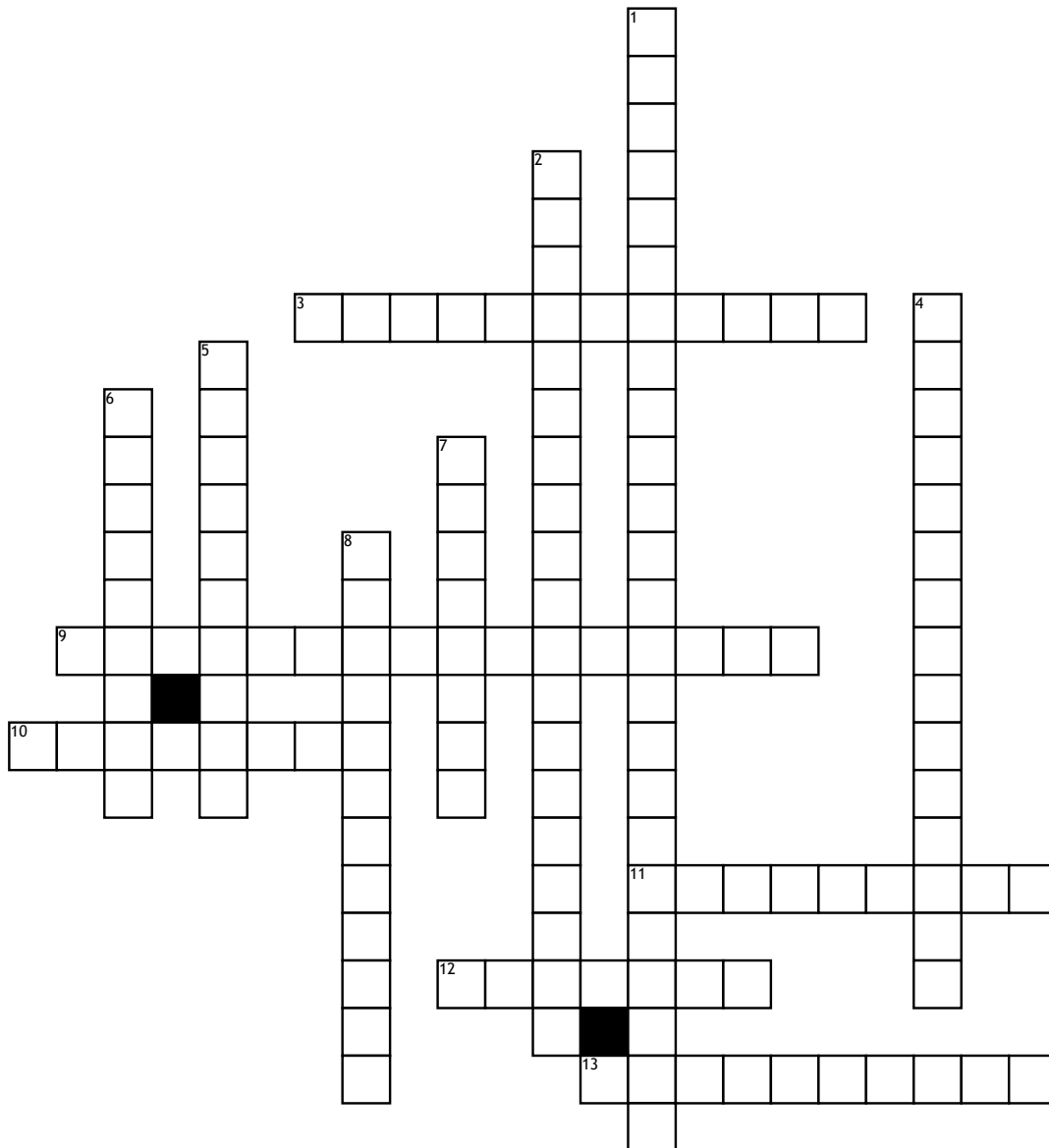

1. An executive order issued by Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, freeing the slaves in all regions behind Confederate lines.

2. An Amendment to the U.S Constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude.

4. Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safer for investors. Its provisions included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspection of banks.

5. Town near Appomattox, Virginia, where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9, 1865, thus ending the Civil War.

6. A tax on earning.

7. An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disaster. Clara Barton founded the American branch in 1881.

8. A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court can determine whether the prisoner is being held legally.
