

- 1. Town near Appomattox, Virginia, where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9, 1865, thus ending the Civil War
- **2.** A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court so that the court can determine whether the prisoner is being held legally
- **4.** Tax on earnings

- **5.** Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safer for investors. It's provision included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspection of banks.
- **6.** The drafting of citizens for military service
- 7. 3 part strategy by which the Union proposed to defeat the Confederacy in the Civil War
- **8.** An amendment to the U.S. Constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude
- **12.** An ironclad ship used by the south in the civil war
