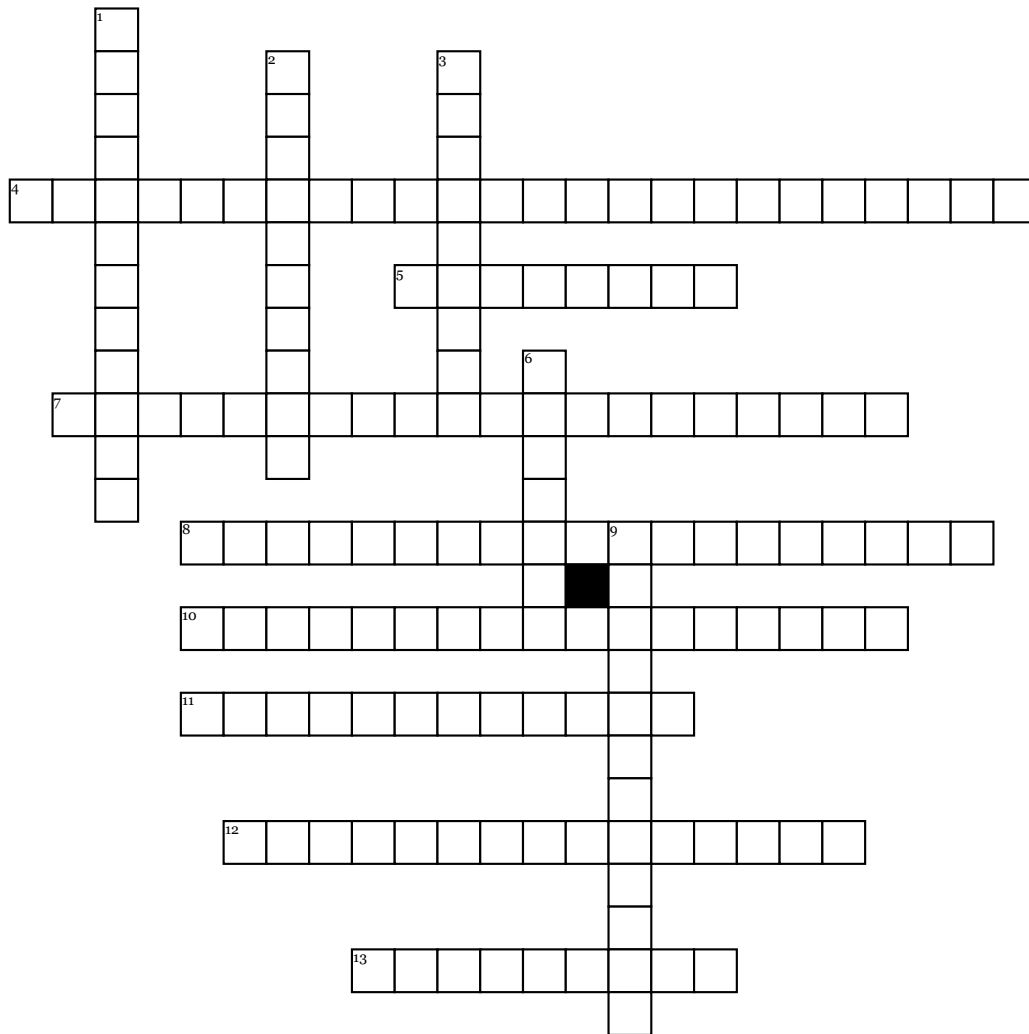

- 5. An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disaster. Clara Barton founded the American Branch in 1881
- 7. Town near Appomattox Virginia where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9th 1865 thus ending the civil war
- 8. An amendment to the U.S. Constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude
