
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## Chapter 11 Vocabulary Civil War



- 4. An executive order issued by Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, freeing the slaves in all regions behind confederate lines
- **5.** An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disaster. Clara Barton founded the American Branch in 1881
- 7. Town near Appomatix Virginia where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9th 1856 thus ending the civil war
- 8. An amendment to the U.S. Constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude

- 10. A famous speech delivered by Abraham Lincoln in November 1863 at the dedication of a national cemetery on the site of the Battle of Gettysburg
- **11.** The drafting of citizens for military service
- 12. Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safer for investors. Its provisions included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspection of banks
- 13. An ironclad ship used by the South in the civil war

- 1. A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court so that the court can determine whether the prisons is being held legally
- 2. Northern Democrat who advocated making peace with the Confederacy during the Civil war
- 3. A tax on earnings
