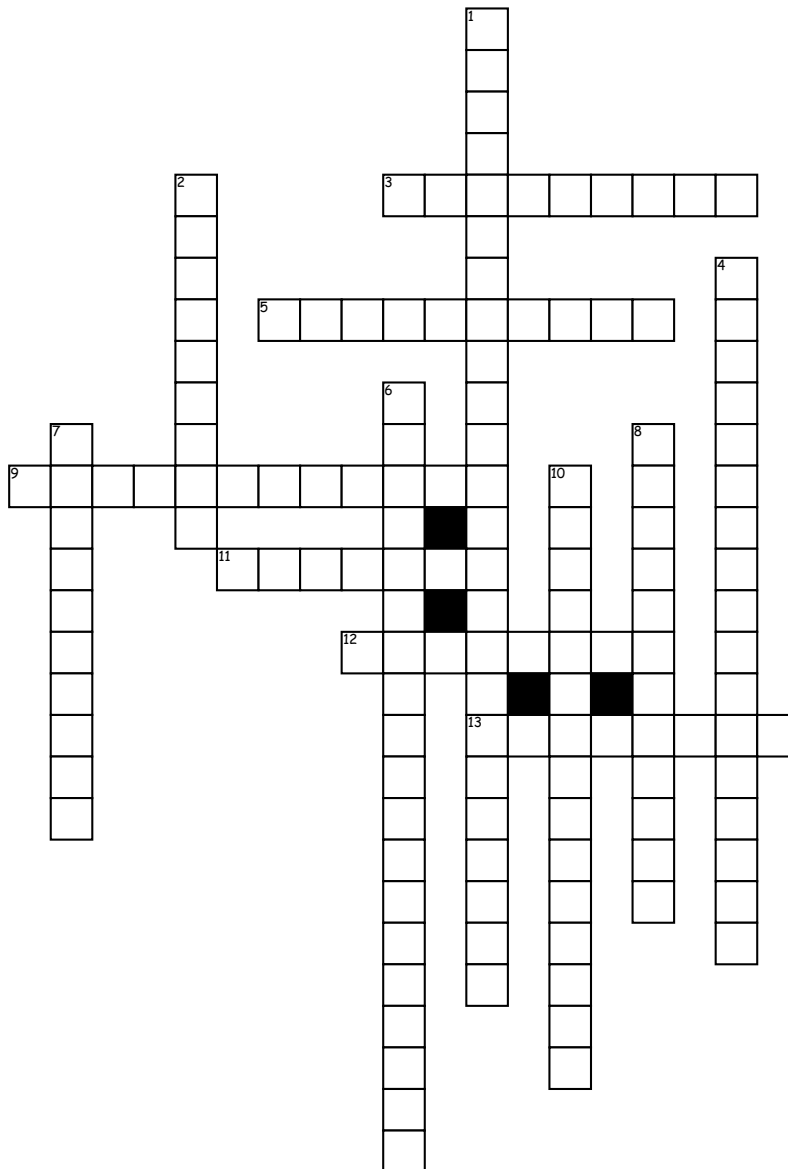

1. An executive order issued by Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, freeing the slaves in all regions behind Confederate lines
2. An ironclad ship used by the south in the civil war.
4. A famous speech delivered by Abraham Lincoln in November 1863, at the dedication of a national cemetery on the site of the battle of Gettysburg

6. An amendment to the U.S. Constitution adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude

7. A Northern Democrat who advocated making peace with the Confederacy during the civil war
8. A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court so that the court can determine whether the prisoner is being held legally

10. Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safe for investors its provisions included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspection of banks
