

- **8.** A northern democrat who advocated making peace with the confederacy during th civil war
- **9.** An executive order issued by Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, freeing the slaves in all religions behind confederate lines.
- **10.** A three part strategy by which the Union proposed to defeat the confederacy in civil war.

- **11.** An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disaster. Clara Barton founded the American branch in 1881.
- **12.** A famous speech delivered by Abraham Lincoln in November 1863, at the dedication of a national cemetery on the site of the battle of Gettysburg.
- 13. Legislation passed in 1863, to make banking safer for investors. It provisions included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspection of banks.
