

- **5.** Partial removal and repair of the stomach
- **7.** Small projection hanging from the posterior middle edge of the soft palate
- 9. Repair of a hernia
- **10.** Pylorus (gatekeeper)
- **11.** Fleshy structures surrounding the mouth
- **13.** Eat or swallow
- 17. Worm-like projection of lymphatic tissue hanging off the cecum; may help to resist infection; also called vermiform appendix (vermi=worm)
- **20.** Lateral walls of the mouth
- 21. Excision of the gallbladder
- 22. Culture and sensitivity

- 23. Third portion of the small intestine
- **24.** Three pairs of exocrine glands in the mouth the secrete saliva; the parotid, the submandibular, and the sublingual glands
- **26.** Portion of the colon that extends upward from the cecum
- **28.** Tissue surrounding the necks of the teeth in the upper and lower jaws' also called gingivae
- 29. Cavity that receives food for digestion also called mouth
- 30. Pancreas
