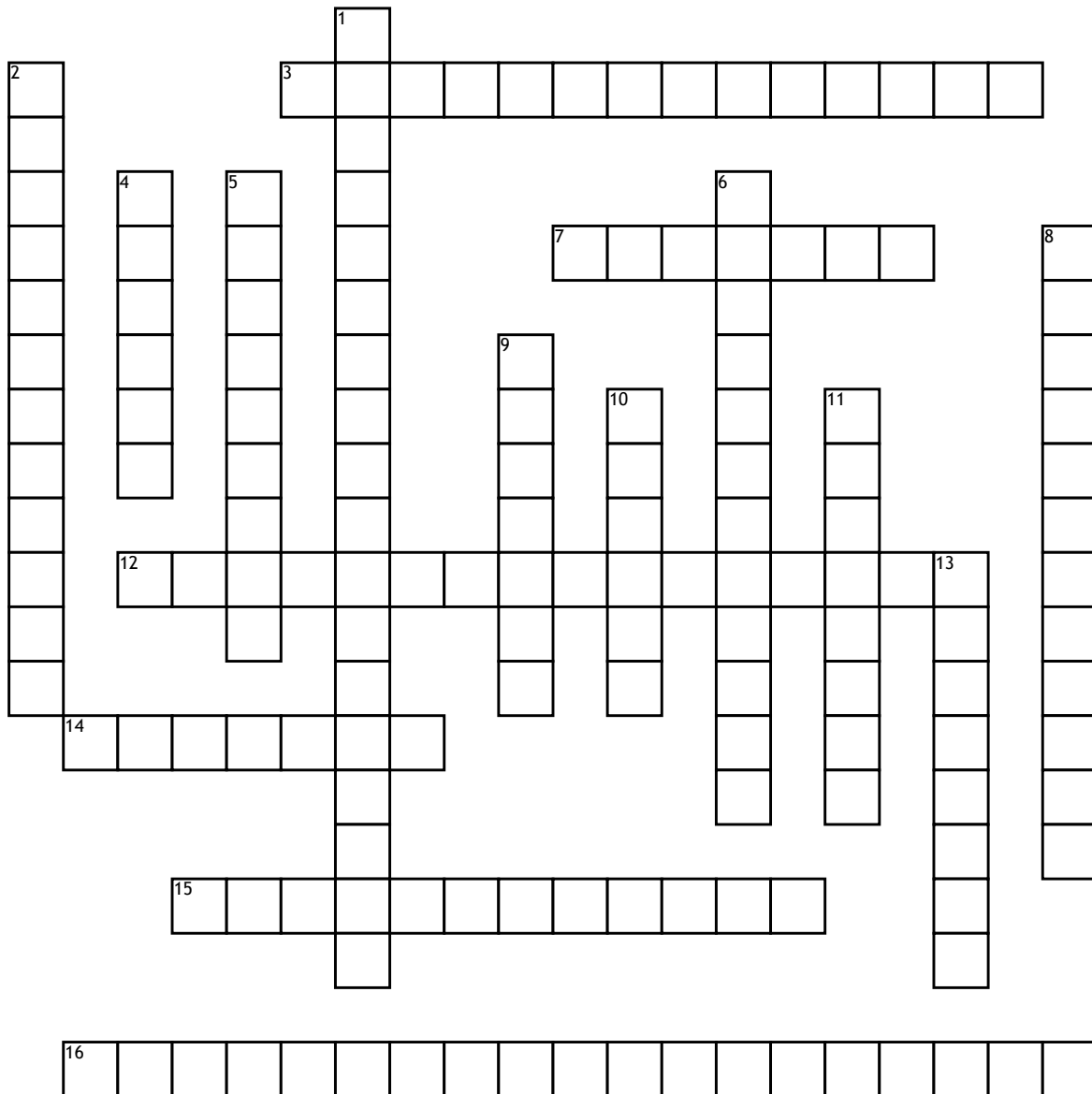


Chapter 12 Crossword
