

7. Abbreviated AC; rapid and interrupted current, flowing first in one direction and then in the opposite direction; produced by mechanical means and changes directions 60 times per second.

11. an extremely low level of electricity that moirrors the bodys natural electrical impulses

12. Switch that automatically interrupts or shuts off an electric circuit at the first indication of overload.

1. Negative pole or positive pole of an electric current.

2. Acronym for light amplification stimulation emission of radiation; a medical device that uses electromagnetic radiation for hair removal and skin treatments.

3. A medical device that uses multiple colors and wavelengths (broad spectrum) of focused light to treat spider veins, hyperpigmentation, rosacea and redness, wrinkles, enlarged hair follicles and pores, and excessive hair.

4. Opposite pole from the active electrode.

5. Abbreviated V and also known as voltage; unit that measures the pressure or force that pushes electric current forward through a conductor.

6. Measurement of the distance between two wavelengths.
