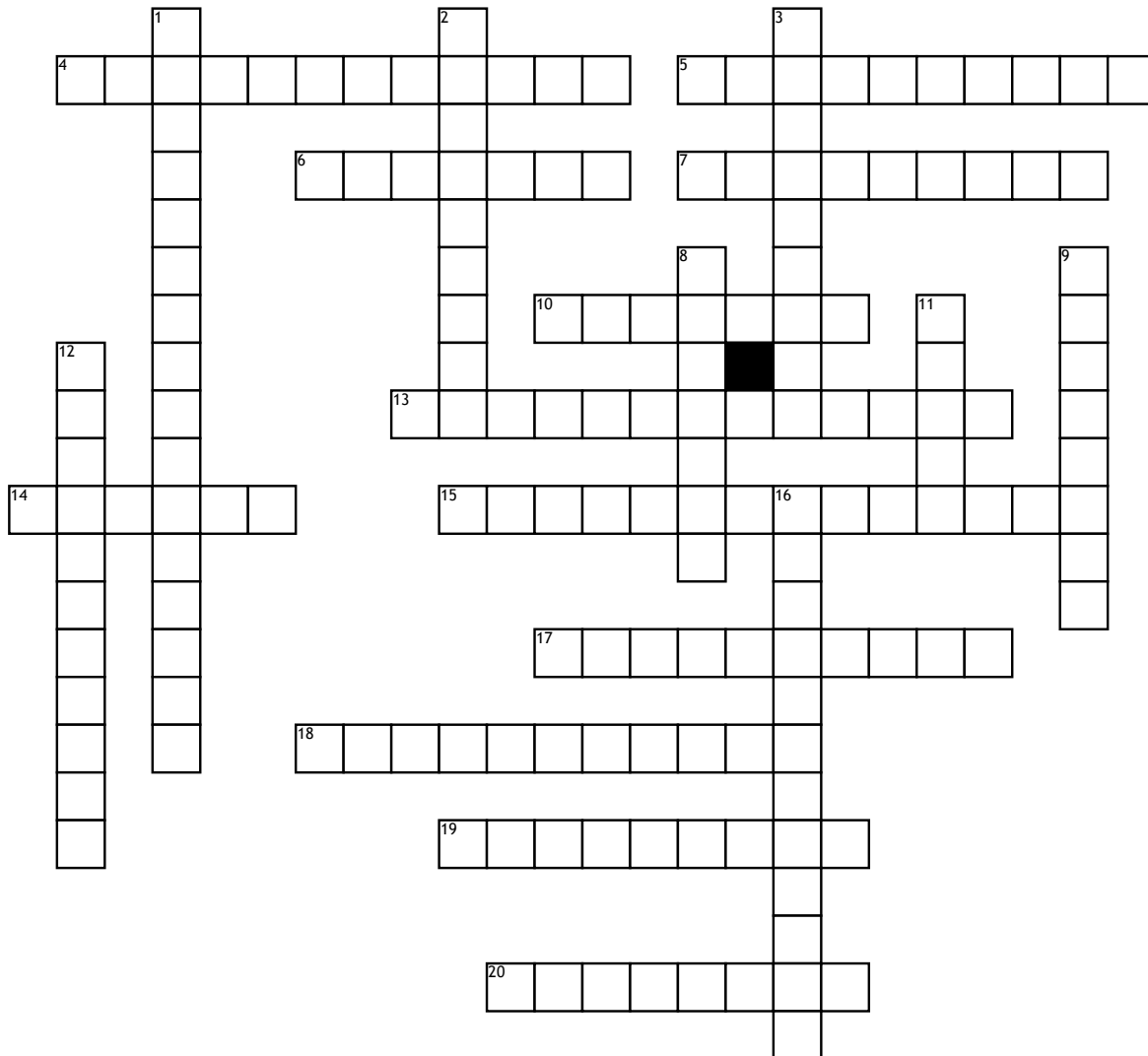


Chapter 16: Lymphatic System

4. mature white blood cells
 5. spongy tissue found in the center of bones
 6. replenishes the remaining spaces of the lobules in the spleen
 7. immature cells
 10. process of fluid being drawn back into the blood capillaries
 13. spaces of the lobules within the spleen
 14. filters the blood within the body

15. the duct that drains lymph from the upper right side of the body
 17. helps destroy infective agents within the tonsils
 18. engulfs and eliminates foreign particles or damaged cells
 19. tiny islands distributed throughout the spleen
 20. pharyngeal tonsils

1. transport bacteria, viruses, and parasitic cells to the lymph nodes

2. site for lymphocyte production
 3. causes lymph nodes to swell up
 8. prevents germs from entering the body through the mouth or nose
 9. the duct that drains lymph from the whole body except the upper right side
 11. excess tissue fluid
 12. white blood cells made in the bone marrow
 16. drains the pits that are located on the surface of the tonsils
