

- **6.** An enormous farm in the Soviet Union of which a large team of laborers were gathered to work together during Joseph Stalin's reign
- **7.** Russian (Georgian) term for dinner party, with many dishes and courses, toasts, and short speeches.
- **9.** The conflict between the United States and the Soviet Union after WW2, called cold because it never escalated into open warfare
- **12.** Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, or Soviet Union, formed in 1922 by the Communist and officially dissolved in 1991
