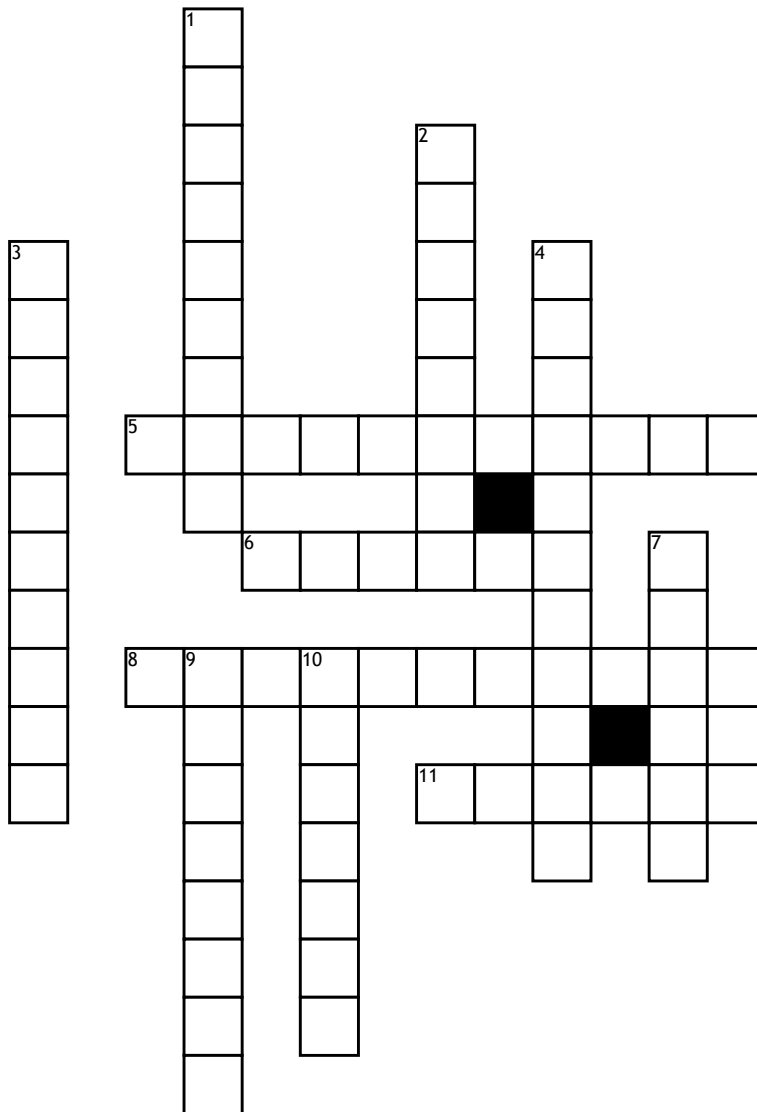

8. Bronfenbrenner's term for influences on development from the general culture, including laws and customs

11. Vygotsky's theory on development that predicts how cultural values, beliefs, and concepts are passed from one generation to the next SOCIOCULTURAL

1. Bronfenbrenner's term for influences that are not a direct part of a child's experience but influences development, such as parent education

2. method for grouping children where children are of different ages FAMILY

3. Bronfenbrenner's term for the second level of influence for the child that involves interactions among the microsystem, such as a teacher in a child care center and family member

4. Bronfenbrenner's term for the innermost lever of influence found in the immediate surroundings of the child, such as parents or the early childhood educator

7. Erikson's stage theory of development including trust, autonomy, identity and intimacy PSYCHOSOCIAL

9. observing large numbers of children to establish average or normal expectations of when a particular skill or ability is present NORMATIVE

10. a method or sequence of events to learn more of each family's cultural beliefs and values regarding the various aspects of child
