

- 2. Comprehensive listing of medical terms and codes for the uniform designation of diagnostic and therapeutic procedures; used in the United States for coding for physician reimbursement and hospital outpatient and ambulatory surgical procedures
- 3. A classification system used in the United States for reporting of impatient hospital procedures

- **4.** Process by which the quality of the care and services provided to the patients within a health care facility is monitored and evaluated
- 5. Professionals who are technical experts in health data collection, analysis, monitoring, maintenance, and reporting activities in accordance with established data quality principles, legal and regulatory standards, and professionals best practice guidlines
- **6.** System for Medicare patients by which a predetermined level of reimbursement is established before services are provided
