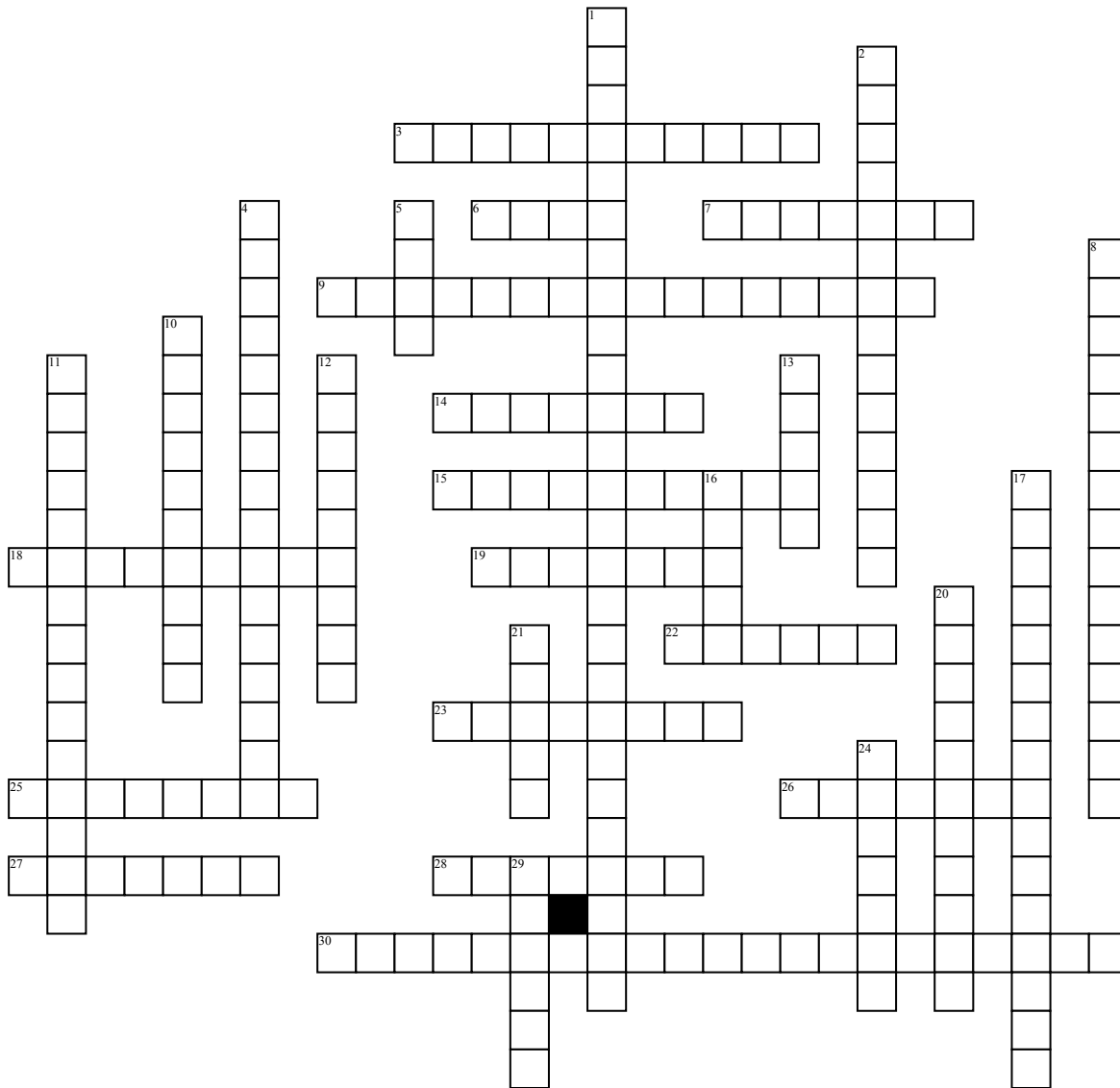

3. a scratch mark
 6. injury to body tissue caused by heat, chemicals, electricity, radiation, or gases
 7. inflammation of the fingernail or toenail
 9. removal of an entire lesion
 14. a linear crack in the skin
 15. any disorder of the skin
 18. an acute contagious disease caused by herpes varicella zoster virus - chickenpox
 19. a term used for measles
 22. an abnormal overgrowth of scar tissue that is thick and irregular (kele = tumor)
 23. malignant neoplasm composed of melanocytes

25. abnormal tissue that grows by more rapid than normal cellular proliferation
 26. an epidermal growth caused by a papilloma virus, also called a wart
 27. a pus-filled sac (e.g., a pimple)
 28. An acute but mild disease caused by rubella virus, also called German Measles
 30. malignant neoplasm of the stratified squamous epithelium

 2. a drug that blocks the effects of histamine in the body
 4. lesions that result in changes to primary lesions
 5. fungus
 8. lesions of a blood vessel
 10. inflammation of the nail fold
 11. a mole with precancerous changes

12. inherited skin disease marked by red, itchy, scaly patches
 13. a dried residue of serum (body liquid), pus, or blood on the skin (e.g., as seen in impetigo)
 16. a thin flake of exfoliated epidermis (e.g., dandruff)
 17. removal of a selected portion of a lesion
 20. infestation with lice that causes itching and dermatitis (pediculo = louse)
 21. a blister larger than 0.5 cm (e.g., a second-degree burn) (bulla = bubble)

 29. removal of a small piece of tissue for microscopic pathologic examination
