

- 2. the part of the body of a mammal between the neck and the abdomen, including the cavity enclosed by the ribs, breastbone, and dorsal vertebrae, and containing the chief organs of circulation and respiration; the chest.
- 3. technical term for shoulder blade
- **6.** the treatment of disease, injury, or deformity by physical methods such as massage, heat treatment, and exercise rather than by drugs or surgery
- 10. technical term for club foot.
- **12.** a triangular bone in the lower back formed from fused vertebrae and situated between the two hipbones of the pelvis
- 13. an electromagnetic wave of high energy and very short wavelength, which is able to pass through many materials opaque to light

- **14.** the inner and typically larger of the two bones between the knee and the ankle (or the equivalent joints in other terrestrial vertebrates), parallel with the fibula.
- **15.** the surgical cutting of a tendon, especially as a remedy for club foot
- **18.** wrench or twist the ligaments of (an ankle, wrist, or other joint) violently so as to cause pain and swelling but not dislocation
