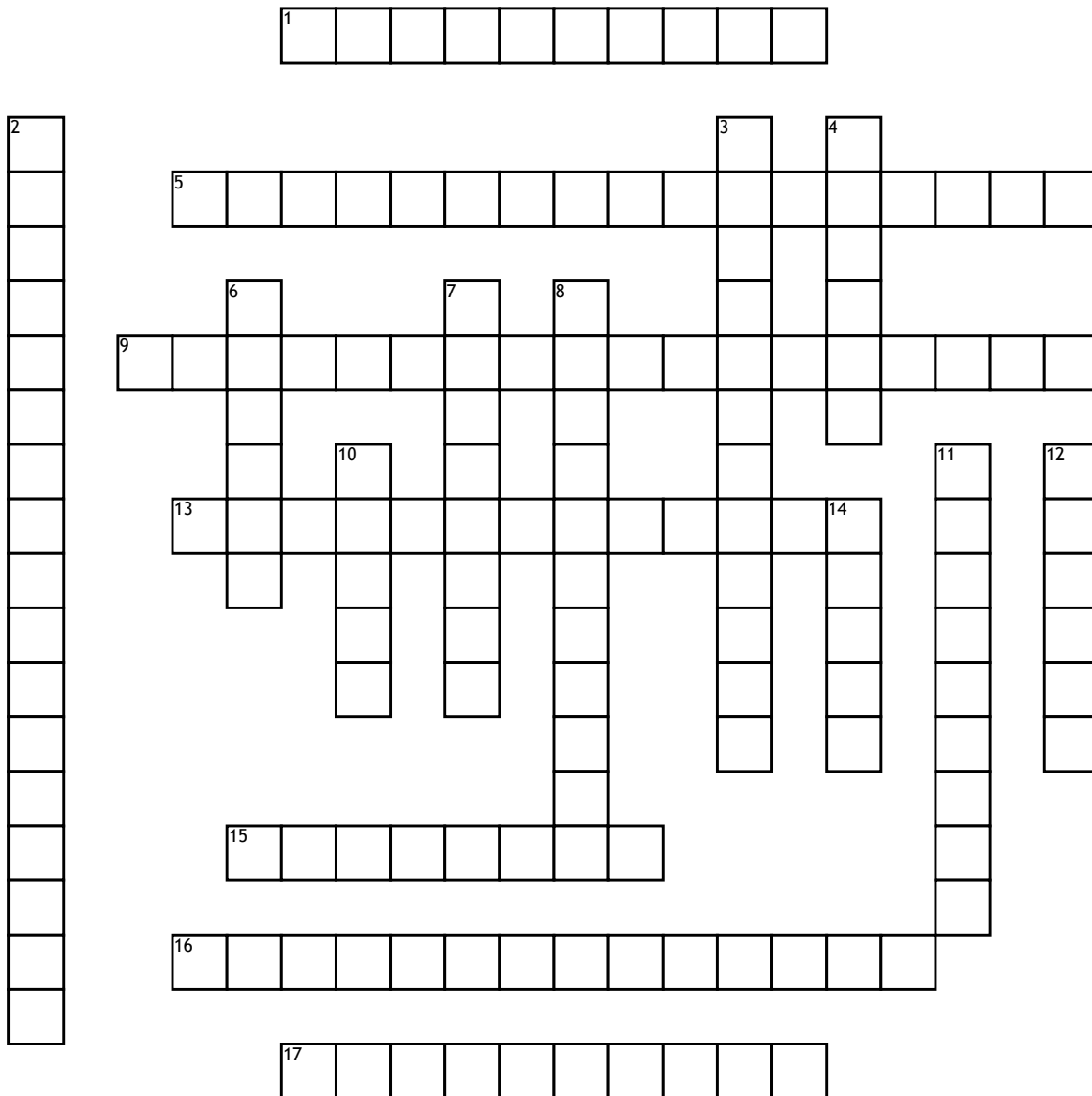

1. Matrix system designed to establish a temporary interproximal wall for the restoration of a tooth surface without the use of a retainer.
5. Dental device used to hold a matrix band in place during restoration of a class II cavity.
9. Term commonly used to describe restorative and esthetic dentistry.
13. Shaping of the cavity walls to aid in retaining the restoration.
15. Excess restorative material that extends beyond the cavity margin.
16. Clear plastic strip used to provide a temporary interproximal wall for the restoration of an anterior tooth surface.

17. Internal surface of a cavity preparation.

2. Process of decay removal and tooth design in preparation for restoring a tooth.
3. Basis of a stronger system used to retain and support a tooth restoration.
4. Foundation that binds or holds the dental material and tooth together during the setting process.
6. Thin layer of composite resin or porcelain bonded or cemented to a prepared facial surface.
7. A space between two teeth.

8. Use of a dental material to restore a tooth or teeth to a functional permanent unit.

10. Wooden or plastic triangular device placed in the embrasure to provide the contour needed when a class II lesion is restored.

11. Junction of two walls in a cavity preparation.

12. Pitted area in a tooth caused by decay.

14. Brand name for clear plastic strip used to provide a temporary wall for restoration of an anterior tooth.
