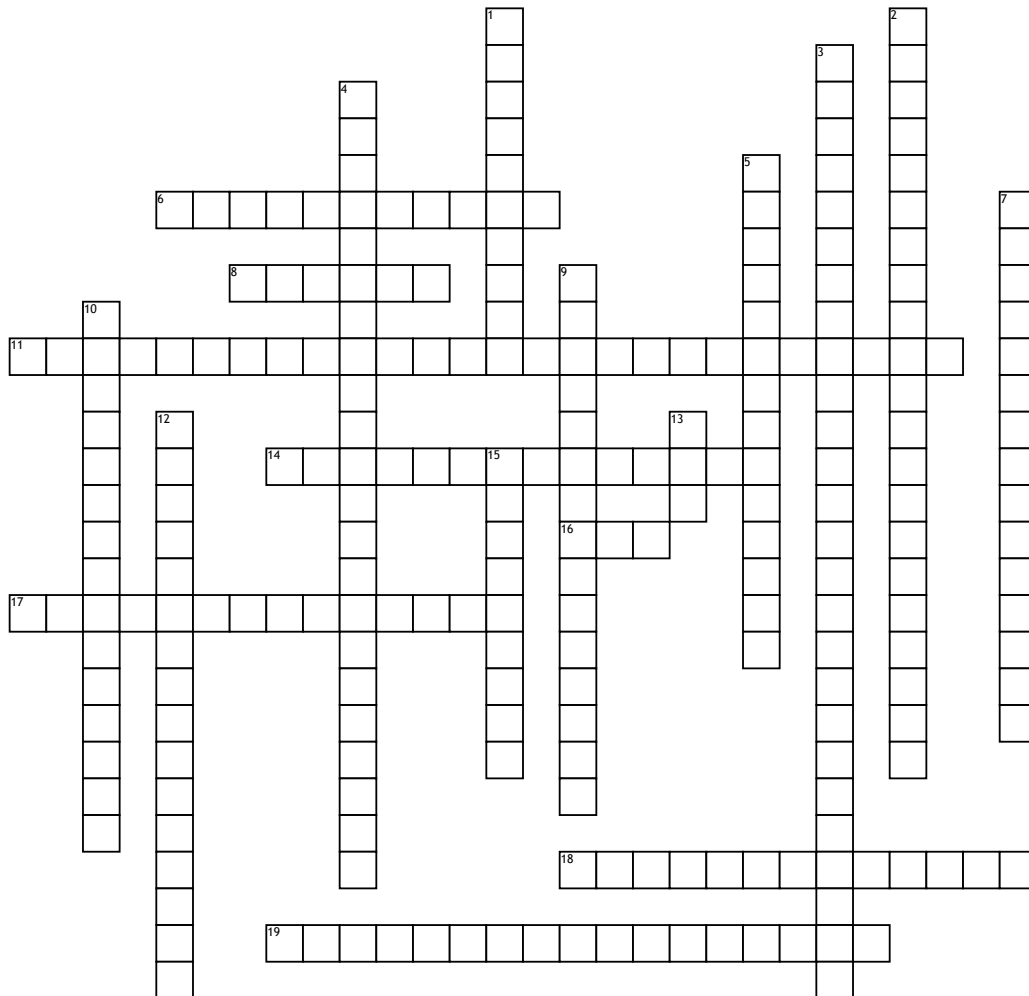

6. Multiple pregnancy with two chorionic sacs.

8. Fertilized ovum resulting from the union of male and female gametes.

11. Hormone secreted by the trophoblastic cells of the blastocyst; laboratory test indicates pregnancy when values are elevated.

14. First site of formation of red blood cells that will nourish the embryo.

16. Intrauterine Pregnancy

17. The villi on the maternal side of the placenta or embryo; unites with the chorion to form the placenta.

18. Production and development of blood cells.

19. Uterine decidua on the surface of the implantation site

1. Multiple pregnancy with two amniotic sacs.

2. interface between the decidua capsularis and the echogenic, highly vascular endometrium.

3. Pregnancy that includes one gestational sac containing one yolk sac, one amniotic membrane, and two embryos within a single amniotic cavity.

4. Invasive diagnostic genetic testing that involves sampling zygotic cells from developing placental tissue.

5. cavity in which the fetus exists; forms early in gestation; fills with amniotic fluid to protect the fetus.

7. Most accurate measurement for determining gestational age; performed in the first trimester.

9. Surrounds the amniotic cavity; the yolk sac is within this cavity.

10. Time between 4 and 10 weeks of gestation.

12. Formed at 23 days when the primary yolk sac is pinched off by the extra embryonic coelom.

13. Mean Sac Diameter

15. The umbilical duct connecting the yolk sac with the embryo.
