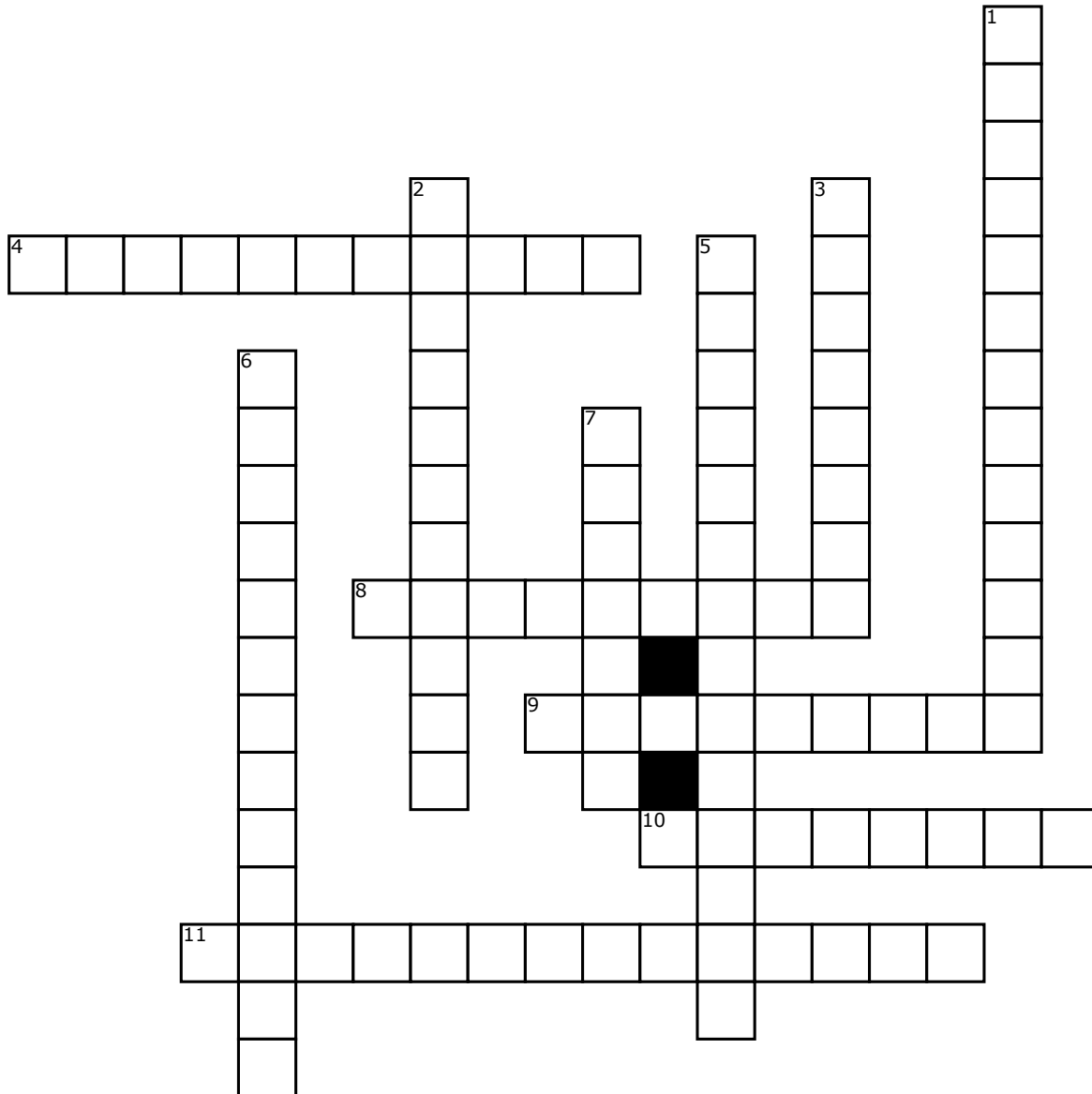


# Chapter 4 Crossword Puzzle
