

- **1.** The first ten amendments to the United States Constitution
- **2.** Tariffs that are enacted with the aim of protecting a domestic industry
- **4.** The Second Continental Congress, chartered a government for the Northwest Territory, provided a method for admitting new states
- **5.** A person who advocates or supports a system of government in which several states unite under a central authority

- 6. An agreement that large and small states reached during the Constitutional Convention of 1787 that in part defined the legislative structure and representation of them
- 7. An agreement among the 13 original states of the United States of America that served as its first constitution
- **9.** A collection of 85 articles and essays written by Alexander Hamilton, James Madison, and John Jay
- **10.** These acts were passed by the Federalist Congress in 1798 and signed into law by President Adams
