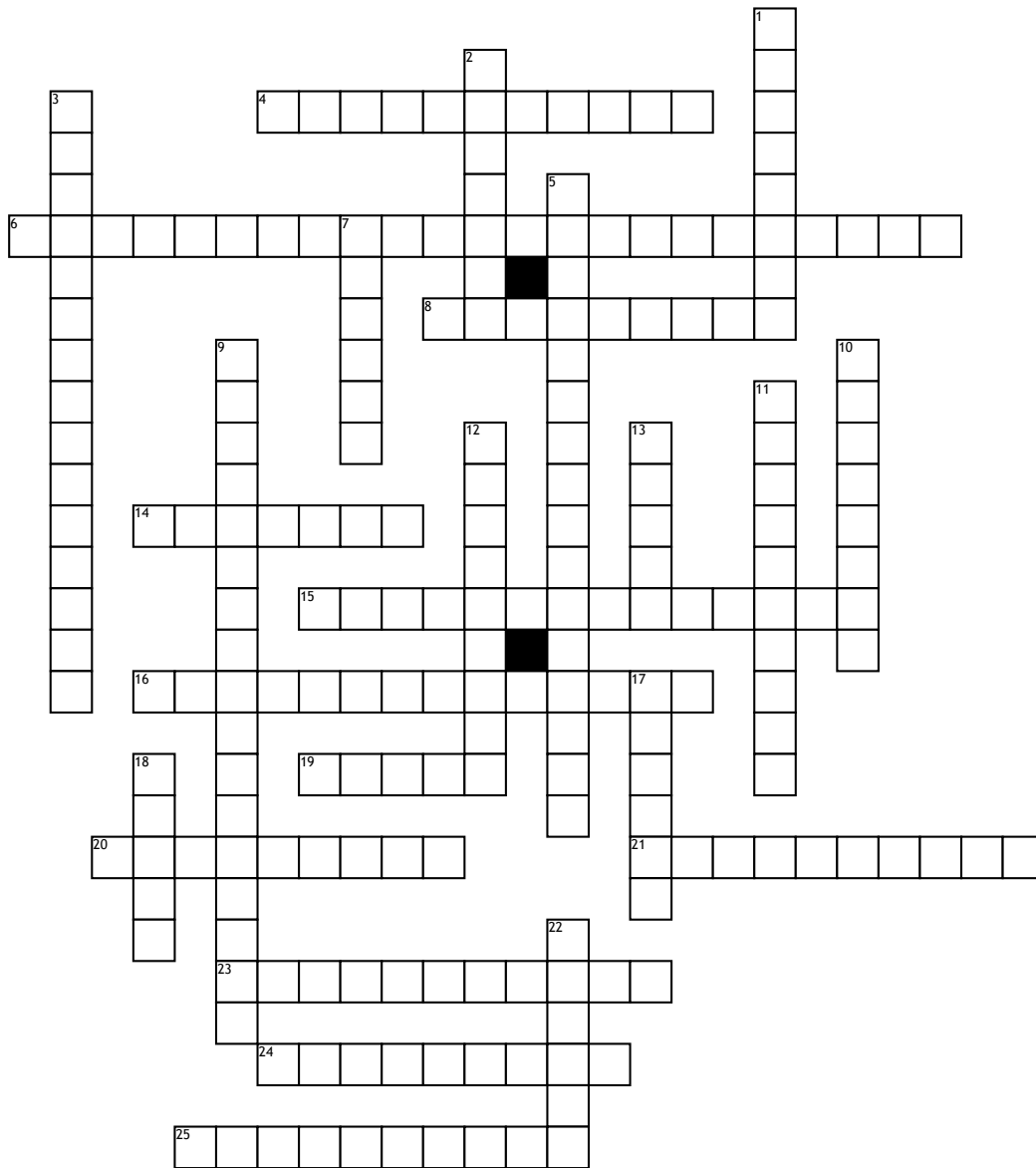

 15. era in which Greek culture spread across western Asia and northeastern Africa after the conquests of Alexander the Great
 16. a religion originating in ancient Iran that became the official religion of the achaemenids
 19. founder of the Achaemenid Empire

21. city on the Mediterranean coast of Egypt founded by Alexander the Great

 24. gathering place on top of a hill where temples or public buildings are located
