

- 1. Tiny canals, radiate from central canal to lacunae
- **2.** Cylindrical end of one bone fits into a trough shaped surface on another bone
- **3.** Bones joined by fibrous tissue; no joint cavity

- **5.** The spherical head of one bone fits into the round socket of another
- **6.** Slightly movable joint
- 8. The end of a long bone
- **9.** Concentric circles of lacunae
- **11.** Mucous membrane lined, air filled cavity in certain cranial bones
- **13.** Giant bone-destroying cells
- **15.** Dense, looks smooth, & homogeneous
