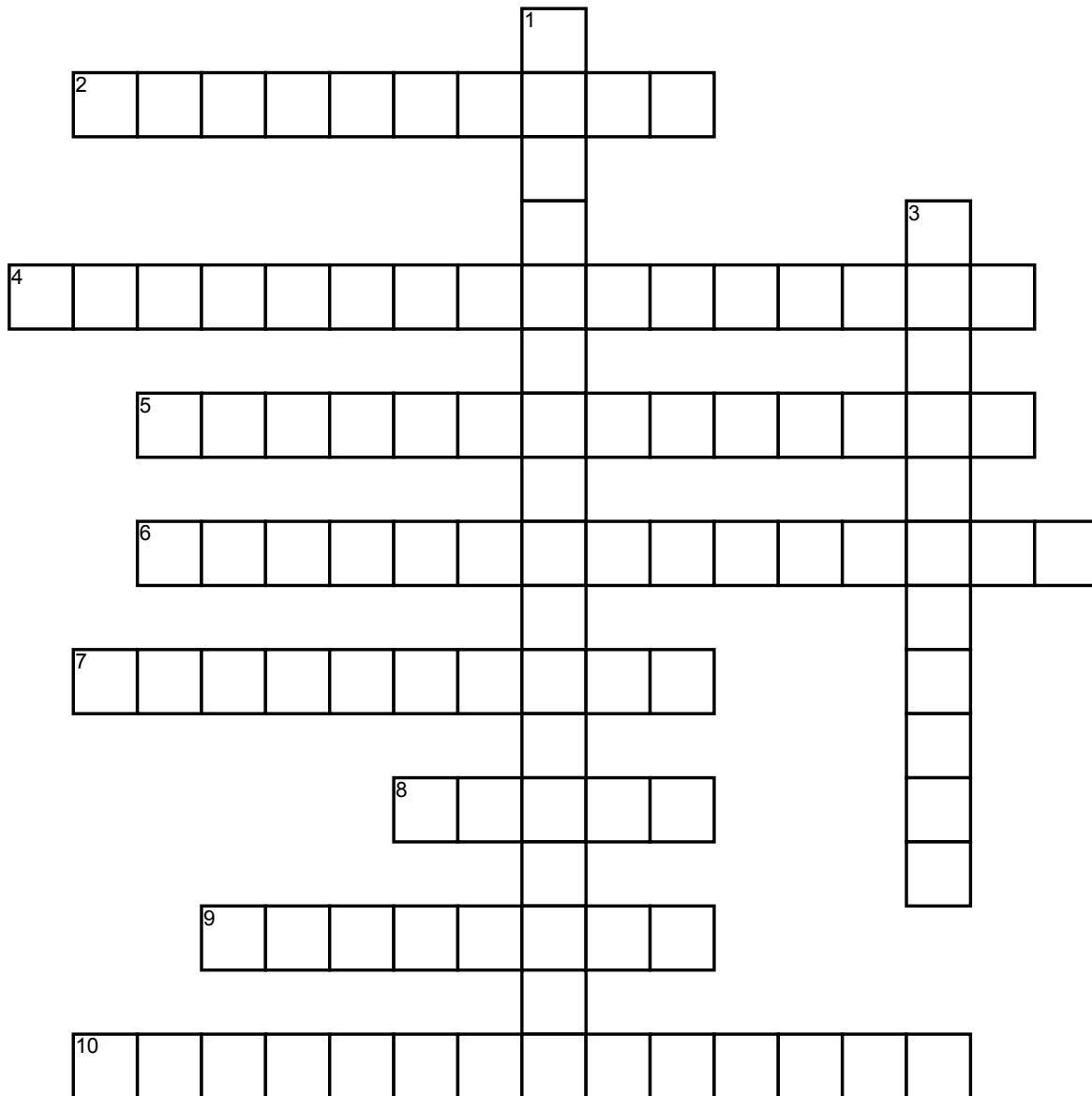

- 6.** The initial act of rule breaking.
- 7.** Crimes involving a willing ex-change of illegal goods or services amount adults.

9. Any behavior, belief, or condition that violates significant social norms in the society of group in which it occurs.

10. A business operation that supplies illegal goods and services for profit.
