

Results from a degeneration of the dopamine-releasing neurons of the substantia nigra
Inflammation of the conjunctiva **8.** Result of damage to the left cerebral hemisphere

9. Genetic disease that leads to degeneration of the basal nuclei & later of the cerebral cortex
