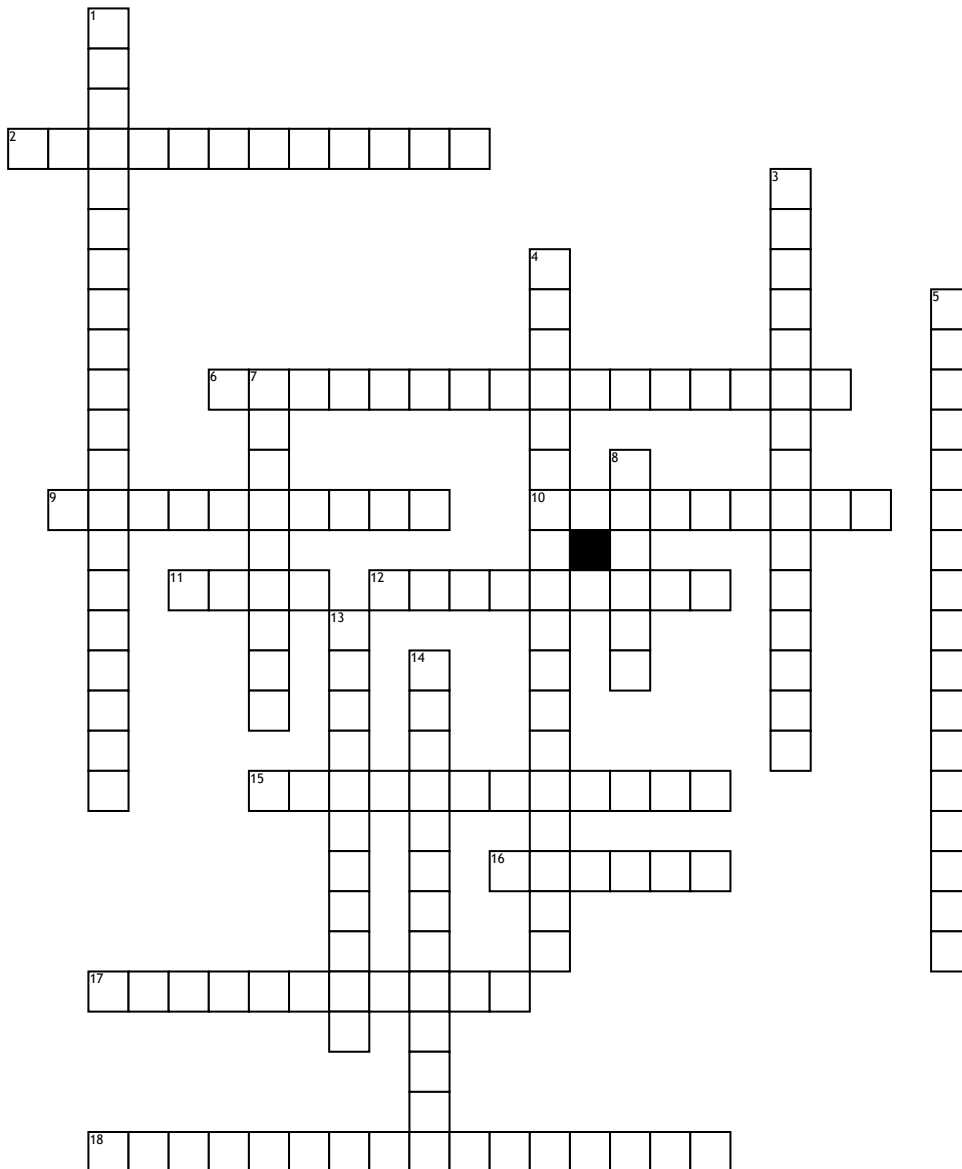

1. a practice, primarily during the eighth century, in which European ships transported slaves from Africa to Caribbean islands, molasses from the Caribbean to Europe, and trade goods from Europe to Africa

3. process in which a more powerful ethnic group forcibly removes a less powerful one in order to create an ethnically homogeneous region
4. state that contains two or more ethnic groups with traditions of self-determination that agree to coexist peacefully by recognizing each other as distinct nationalities
5. concept that ethnicities have the right to govern themselves
7. identity with a group of people that share distinct physical and mental traits as a product of common heredity and cultural traditions
8. a person who subscribes to the beliefs of racism

14. process by which within a state breaks down through conflicts among its ethnicities
