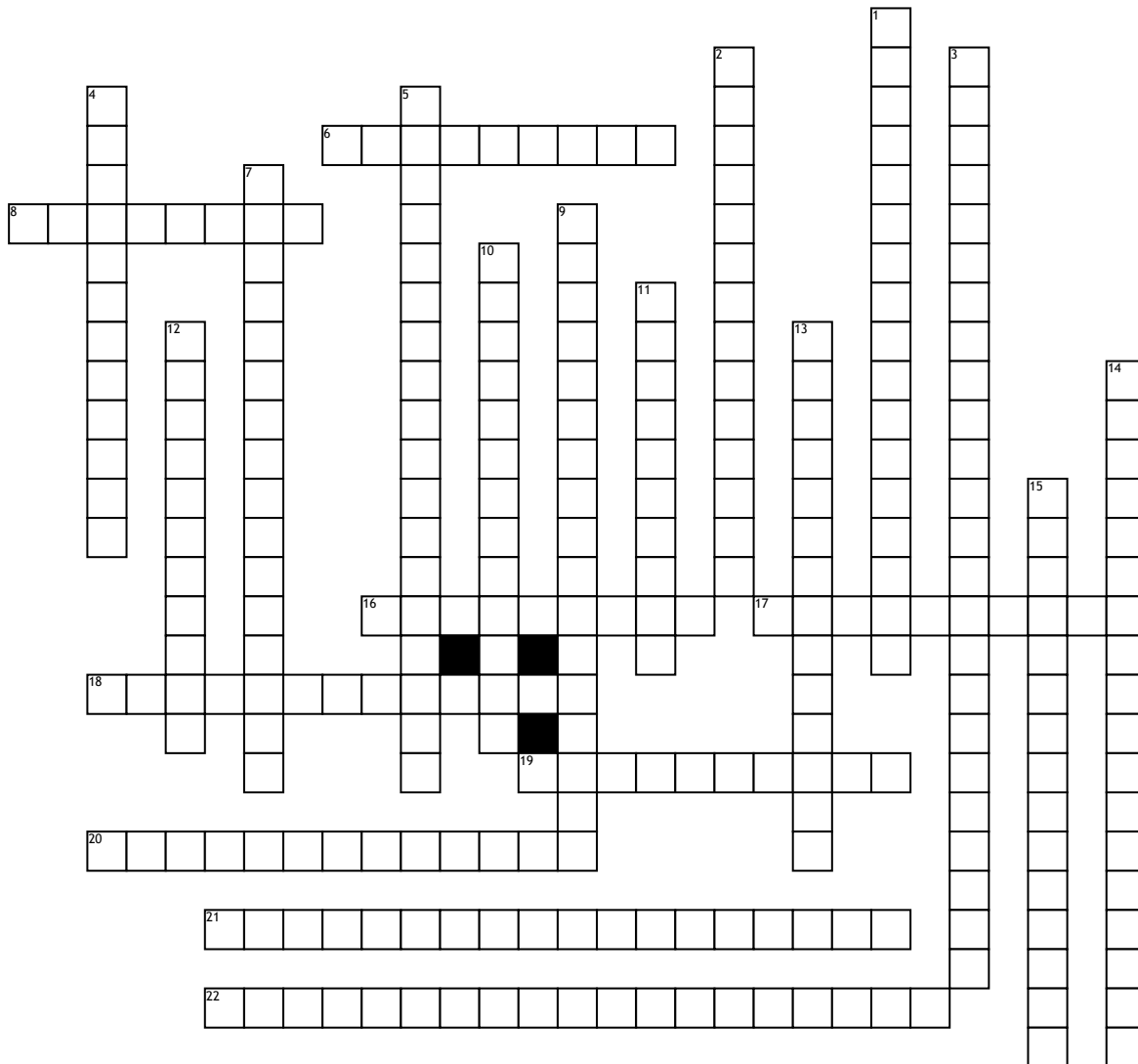

1. Each branch of government has a job that when combined form the national government  
 2. Led by Daniel Shay, a farmers rebellion because he had no money and they were going to take his farm away, was the last straw in showing how weak the Articles Of Confederation were.  
 3. Divided into 3 but no more than 5 states. Each had to go through 3 stages to become a state.  
 4. Who is known as the father of the Constition?  
 5. A group of soldiers wanted to overthrow the government because they were not getting paid and establish a monarchy or a dictatorship with George Washington at the helm.
