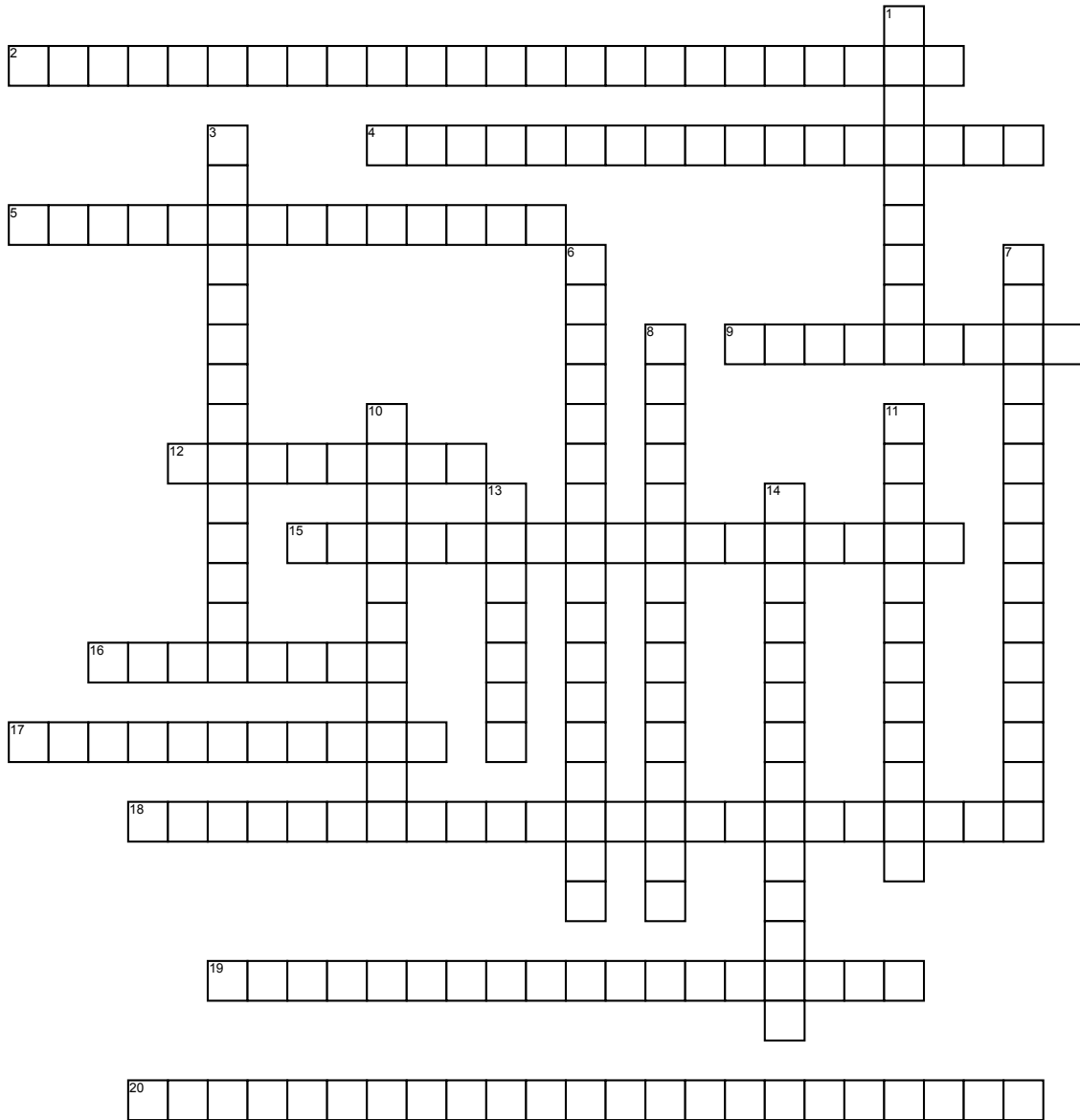


Chapter 8 Crossword Puzzle

- 2. Was held in Olympia and began on July 4, 1889
- 4. This began to flourish especially in Eastern WA
- 5. They produced wheat, barley, oats, and hay without irrigation
- 9. Known as "Empire Builder" in the northern United States
- 12. They needed the grazing lands of the foothills of the Okanogan Highlands, Blue Mountains, Cascade Mountains, and Rocky Mountains to raise cattle, horses and sheep
- 15. They used irrigation water to raise fruits and vegetables
- 16. the financier and owner of the Northern Pacific railway from 1863-1873

- 17. was an enabling act allowing WA to hold a constitutional convention in the summer
- 18. Was supposed to be built from Duluth, Minnesota to Tacoma, Washington
- 19. This forbade new immigrants from coming into the United States from China
- 20. Made it possible to buy fresh salmon for consumption
