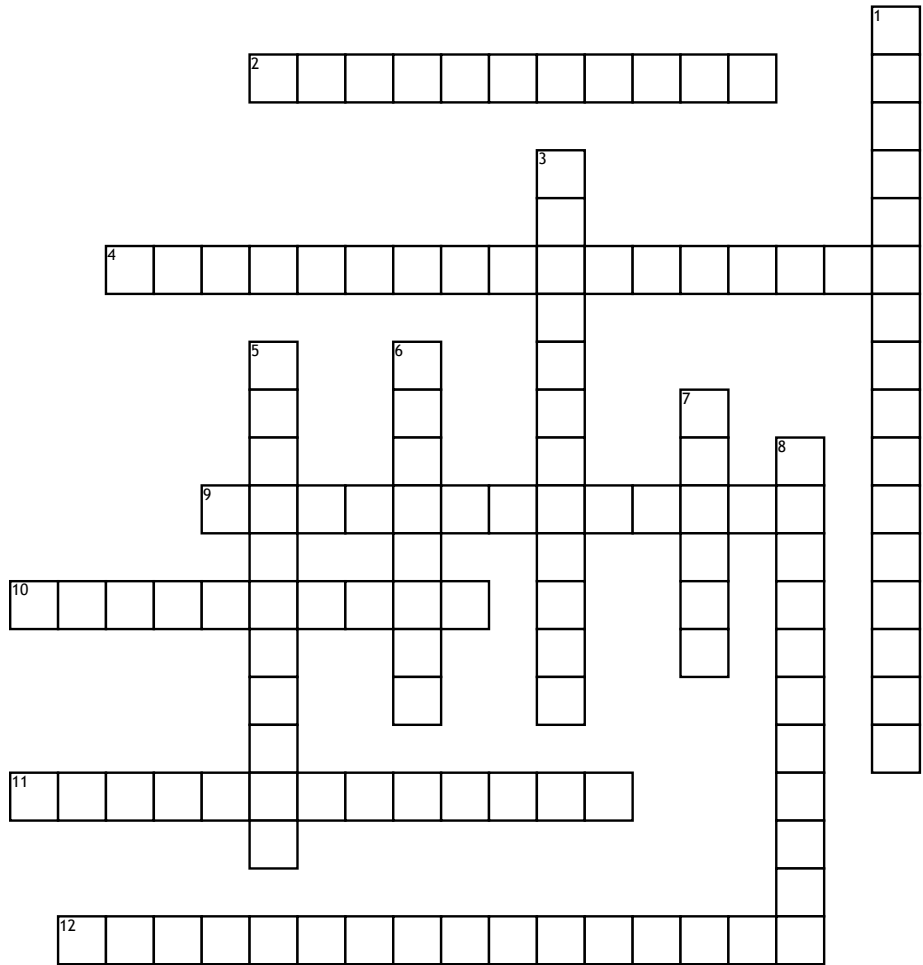
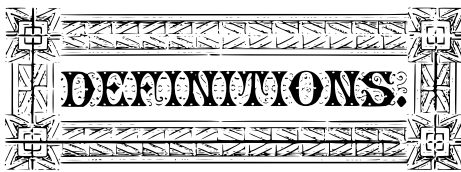

2. Abnormal colorations of the skin that accompany many skin disorders and systemic disorders.

10. Inflammatory condition of the skin.
