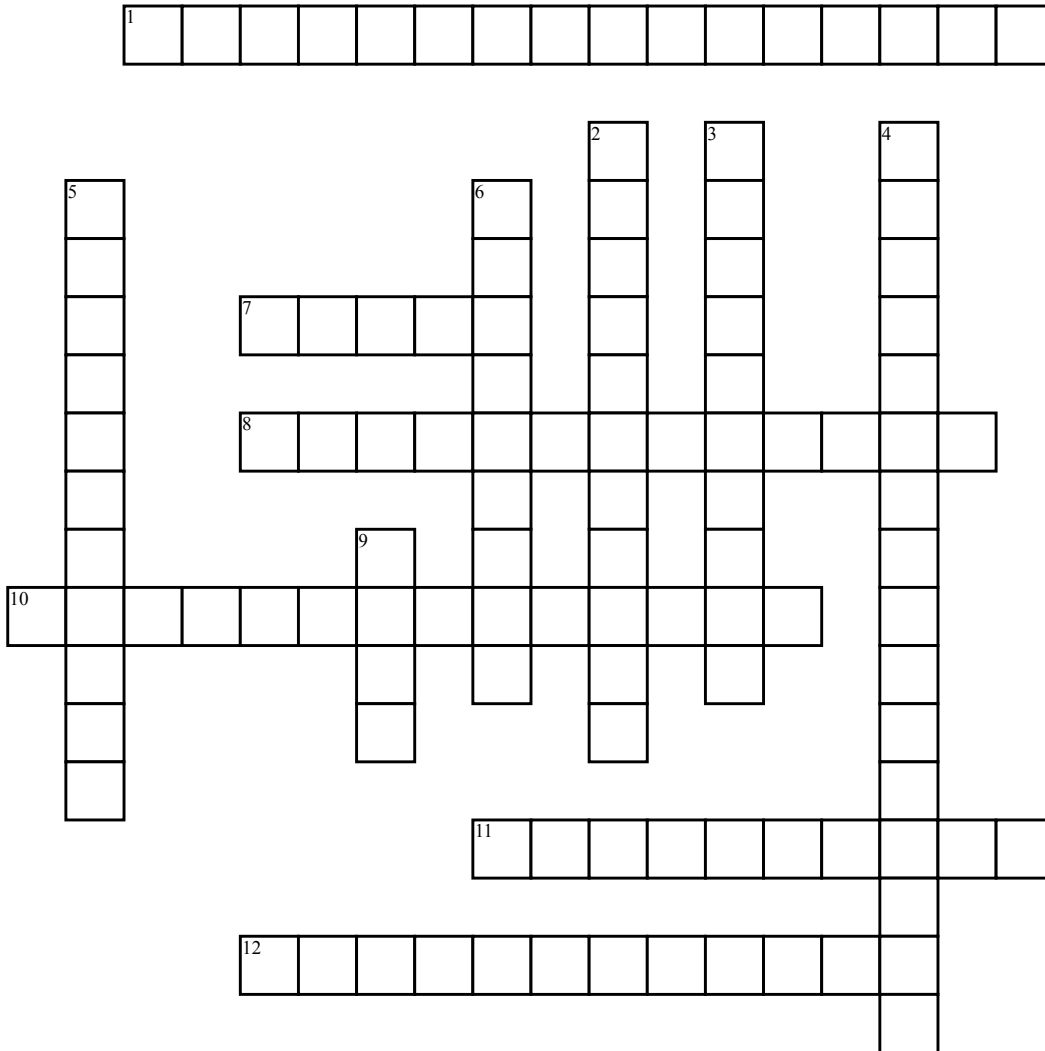


# Chapter 8: Skin Disorders
