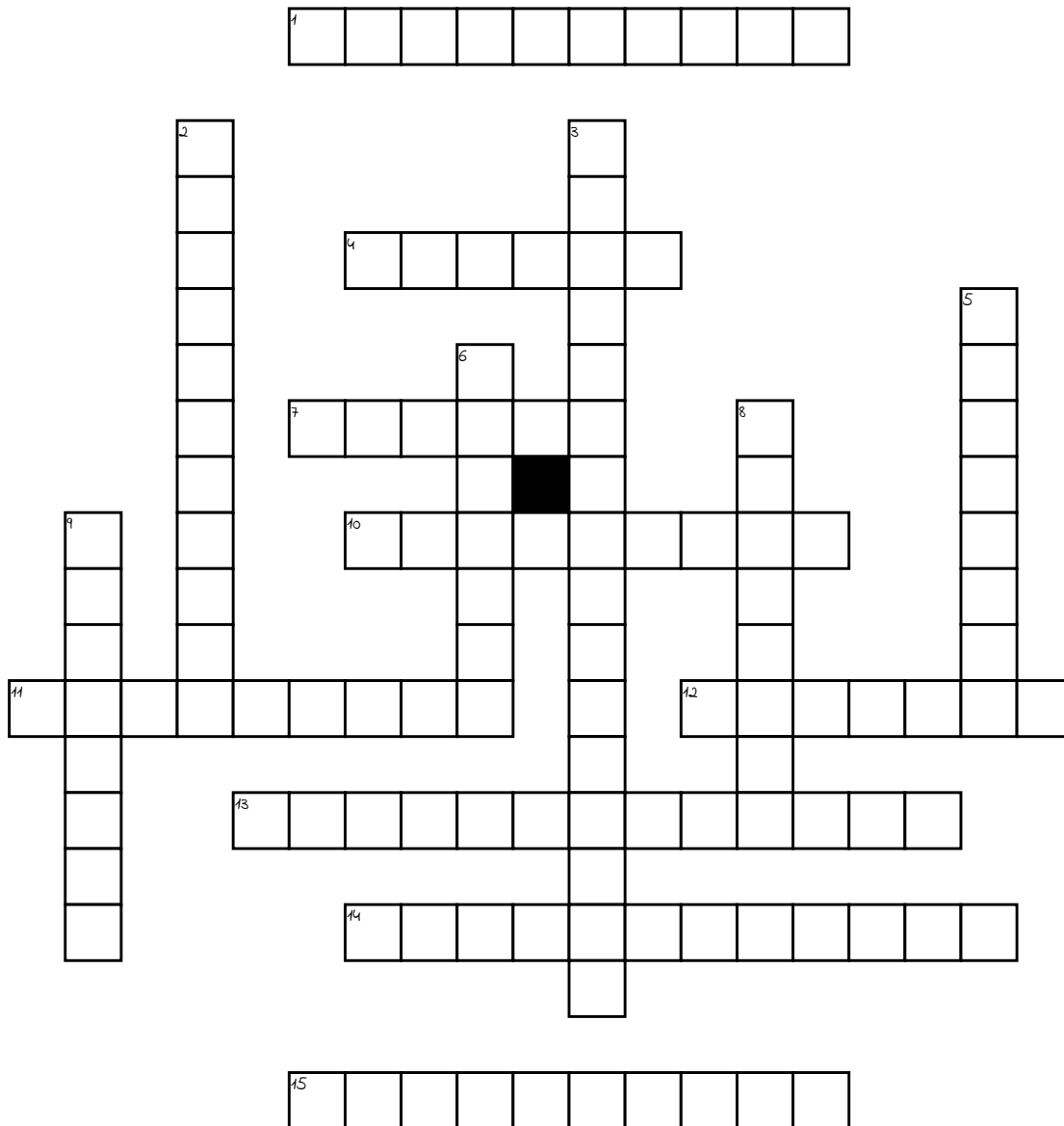

1. Living skin at the base of the natural nail plate
4. The area where the nail plate cells are formed.
7. The visible part of the Matrix that extends from underneath the living skin.
10. Folds of normal skin that surrounds the Nail Plate.
11. Hardened Keratin plate that sits on and covers the Nail Bed.

12. The portion of living skin that supports the nail plateau it grows.

13. Thin layer of tissue that connects the nail to the nail plate

14. Living skin bordering the root and sides of a fingernail or toenail.

15. Formed by the Nail Folds.

2. (Onyx) hard protective plate composed mainly of Keratin.

3. Abnormal shape or form of the nail.

5. Is the part of the Nail Plate that extends over the tip of the finger or toe.

6. Dead colorless tissue attached to the natural Nail Plate.

8. (Lateral Nail Fold) fold of skin overlapping the side of the nail.

9. A tough band of fibrous tissue that connects bones or hold an organ in place
