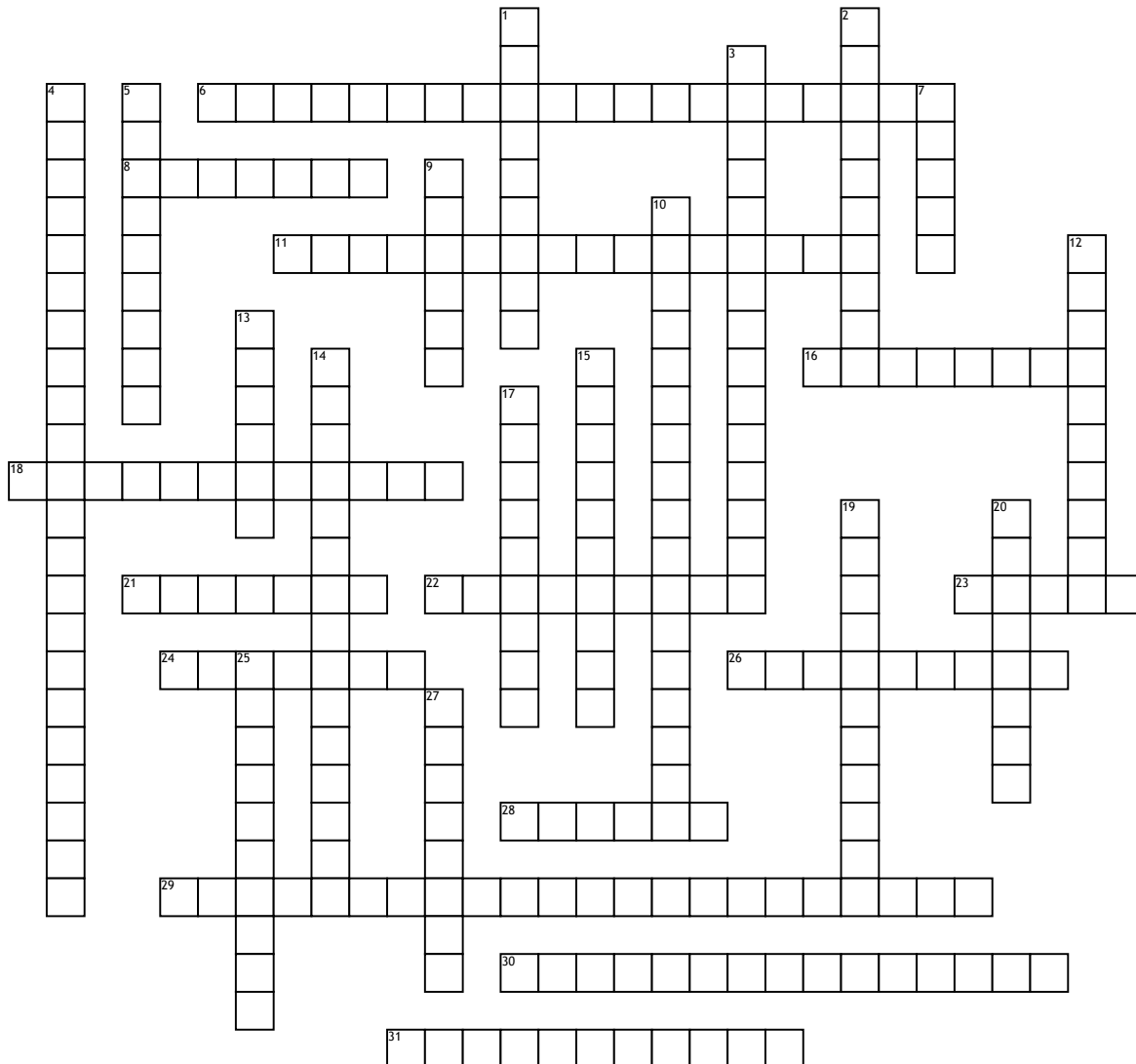

 29. Workers who have decided to leave one job and look for another; typically, frictionally unemployed workers are out of the labor market for short periods of time

1. A group of individuals occupying a house, apartment, group of rooms, or a single room that is considered a housing unit
 2. A real or imagined "choice" between alternatives and the possibility of rank ordering these alternatives, based on the happiness, satisfaction, gratification, enjoyment, and utility they provide
 3. Items that generally last for only a short time
 4. Unemployment caused by basic changes in overall economy, as in demographics, technology, or industrial organization
 5. An increase in the supply of currency or credit relative to the availability of goods and services, resulting in higher prices
 7. A personal preference or liking
 9. A quantity of something on hand or available, as for use
 10. The adoption of industrial methods of production and manufacturing by a country or group, with all the associated changes in lifestyle, transport, and other aspects of society

 14. An opportunity forgone; what is lost because a decision is made
 15. People ages 16 years or older who are employed or looking for work
 17. Any interdependent or mutually beneficial relationship between two persons, groups
