

- **2.** treats Parkinson's disease and relieves tremors and rigidity
- 4. treat and control MG
- **11.** increases urination in urinary retention
- **12.** treats HTN, angina, prophylaxis, and acute MI
- **14.** Constricts pupil to promote draining of the aqueous humor
- **15.** Emergency drug to treat anaphylaxis

- **17.** Treats angina, HTN and liver enzymes will need to be monitored
- **18.** Short term treatment of muscle spasms, decreases pain therefor increases ROM

Down

- 1. Treats HF, left or right. can be used to correct A-FIB, Atrial Flutter, or other cardiac dysrhythmias
- **3.** treats advanced Parkinson's disease. Stop abruptly if fever or confusion develop
- **5.** treats angina, AMI, HTN crisis, HF. Takes 1-3 minutes to work

- **6.** Used in emergency to treat V-TACH
- **7.** decreases urinary frequency, urgency, and incontinence
- **8.** decreases involuntary symptoms of parkinsonism
- 9. used for HTN and PVCs
- **10.** Improves memory loss in Alzheimer's disease
- 13. increases HR for bradycardia
- **16.** Treats HF and A-FIB. This medication will need to be monitored for white, green, or yellow halos around objects indicating a toxicity
