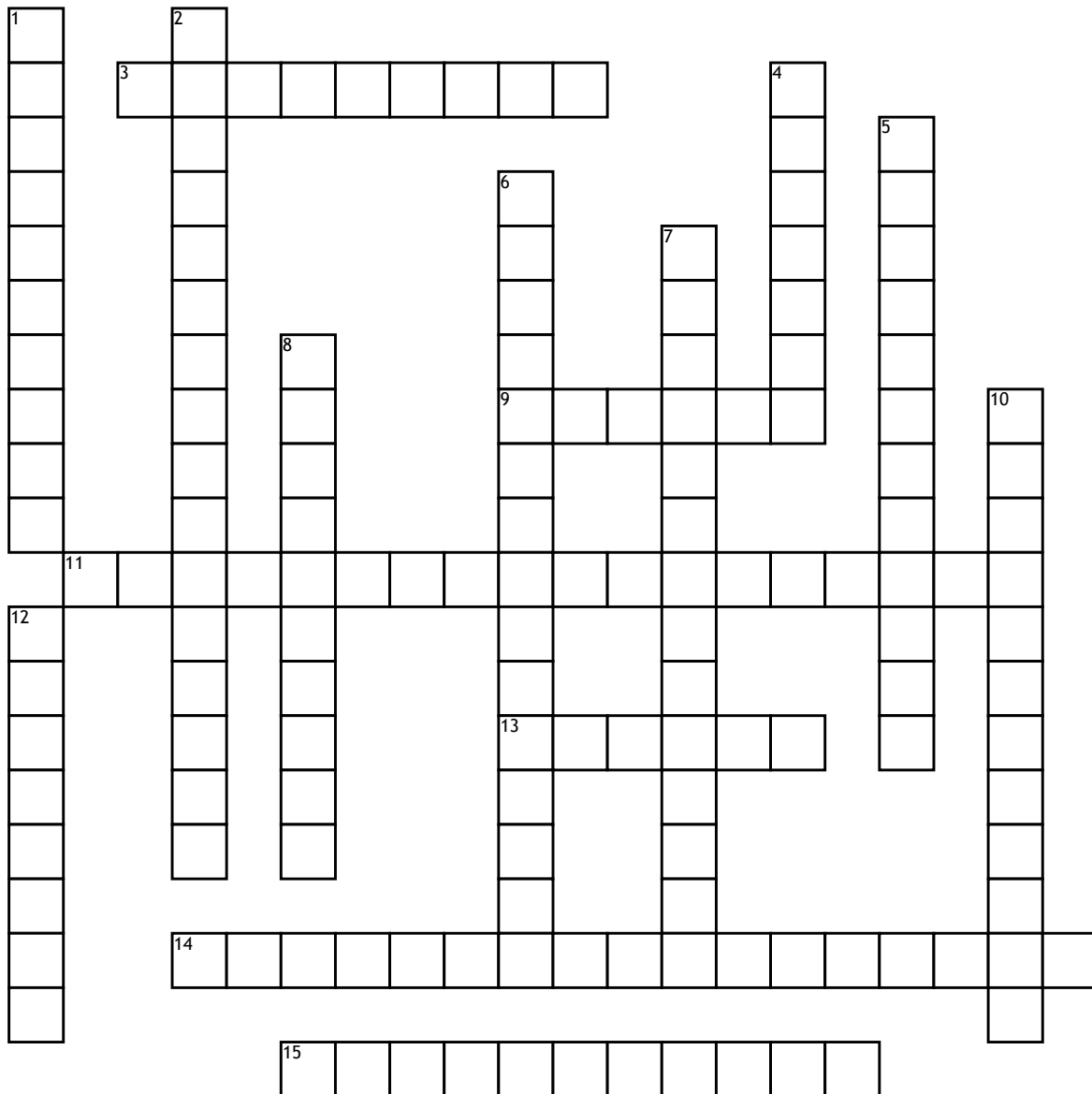

- 2. The US program to develop an atomic bomb for use in World War II
- 4. A political philosophy that advocates a strong, centralized, nationalistic government headed by a powerful dictator

- 6. A 1941 declaration of principles in which the US and Great Britain set forth their goals in opposing the Axis Powers
- 7. A 1944 law that provided financial and educational benefits for World War II veterans
