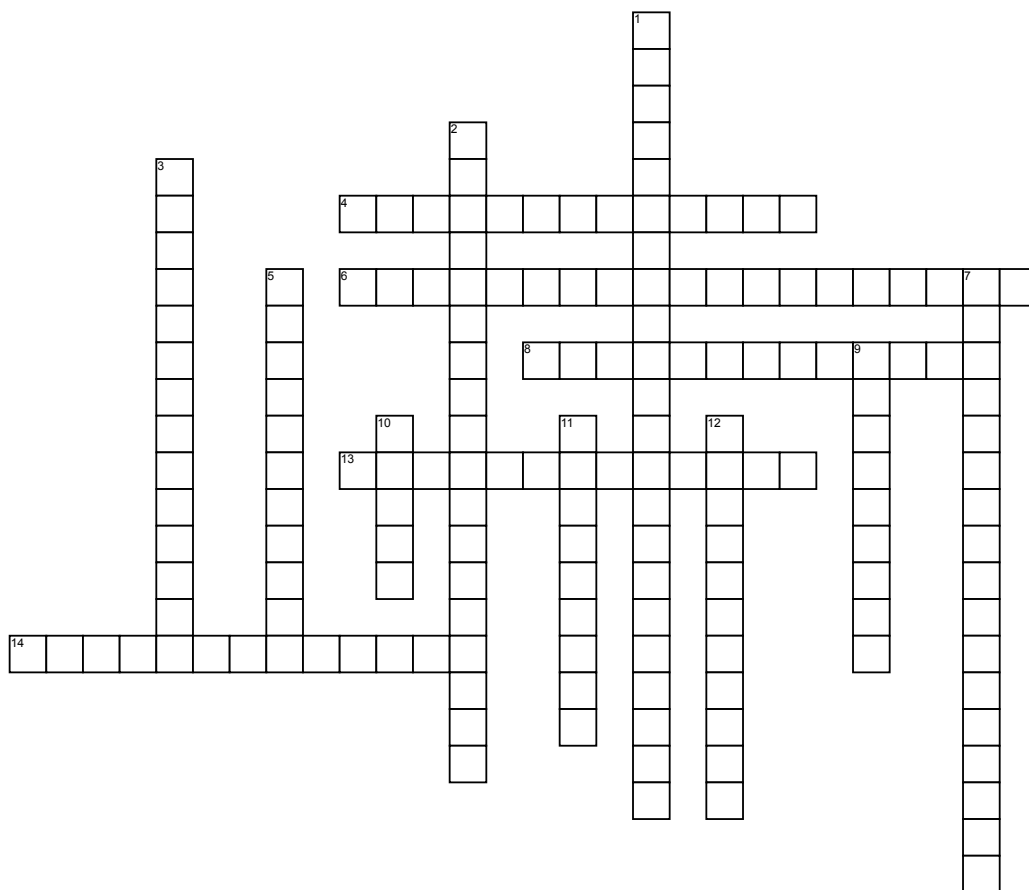

- 4.** A record of a bank customer's signature used by the bank to verify the customer's identity.
6. A line of credit for overdrawn checks.
8. The electronic transfer of a payment directly from the payer's bank account to the account of the person being paid.
13. Checkbook log in which an account holder records checking account transactions.

- 14.** The bank's record of all the transactions in a bank account.

- 1.** An account that pays earned interest on the balance for the depositor.
2. Process of seeing whether an account holder's records agree with a bank's records for an account.
3. Checks that have been cashed.
5. Signature of the payee on the back of the check.

- 7.** Checks that have been written but have not yet been cashed.

- 9.** Having written checks for more money than the balance in the account.

- 10.** Written order directing a bank to pay money on demand to a person or company named on it.

- 11.** bank card that immediately takes money from a checking account when it is used.

- 12.** An order for a bank not to cash a particular check.
