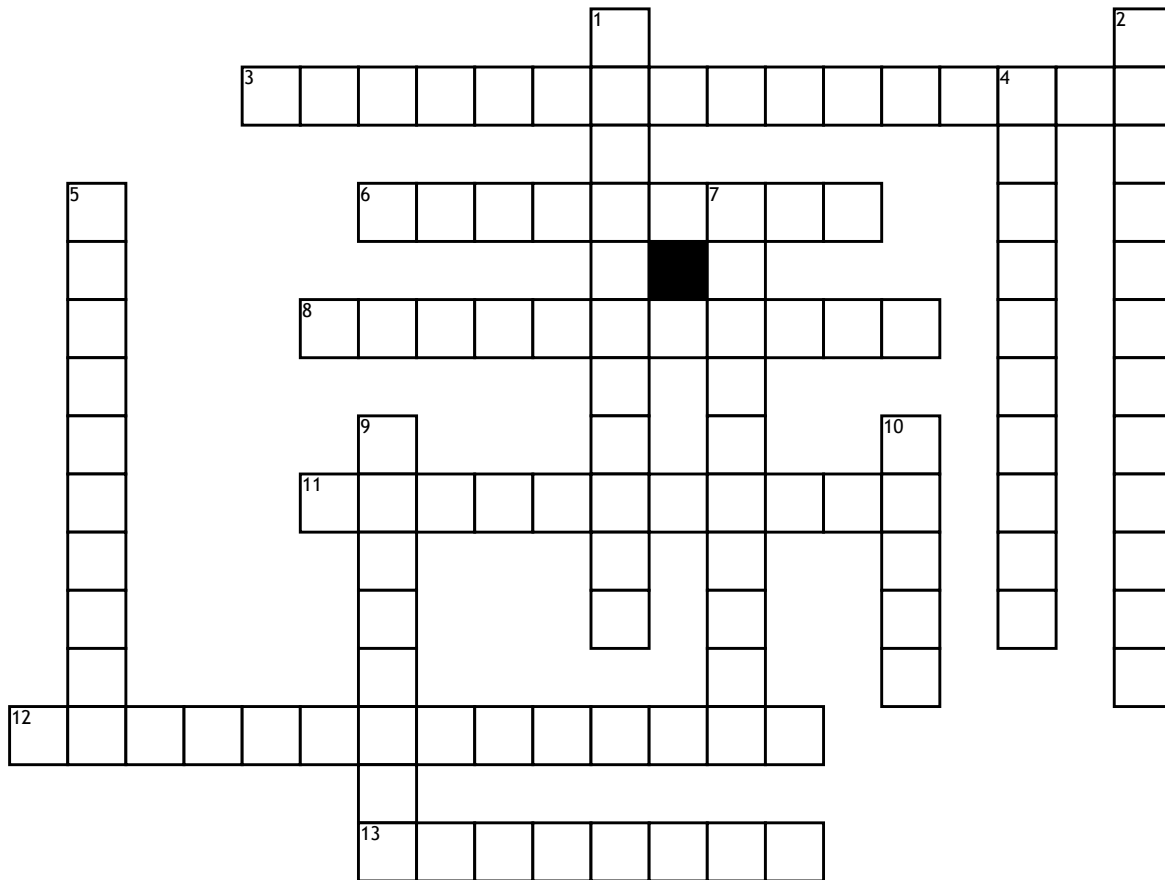

# Chemotherapy Drugs



## Across

3. Monitor urine for blood, send UA every shift, strict I & O.

6. Monitor BP every 15 min, severe hypotension can happen during infusion

8. Urine will turn red, vesicant check for blood return during infusion

11. most common side effect is constipation

12. Take preferably on an empty stomach; 2hrs before or 2 hrs after meal

13. can cause bone pain, offer warm compress, only compatible with D5

## Down

1. Give on an empty stomach; Do not give milk

2. leucovorin must be administered exactly on time.; check for pH and specific gravity prior to start

4. Severe risk of hemorrhagic cystitis if given without protection and mesna.

5. administer with patient lying down flat; Monitor BP every 3-5 min during infusion. Hypotension can occur. Have normal saline ready.

7. can cause severe diarrhea; monitor for severe skin breakdown

9. need adequate prehydration, send Ua prior to starting medication, can cause metallic taste, provide good oral hygiene

10. may cause false positive for urine ketones; not compatible with cisplatin
