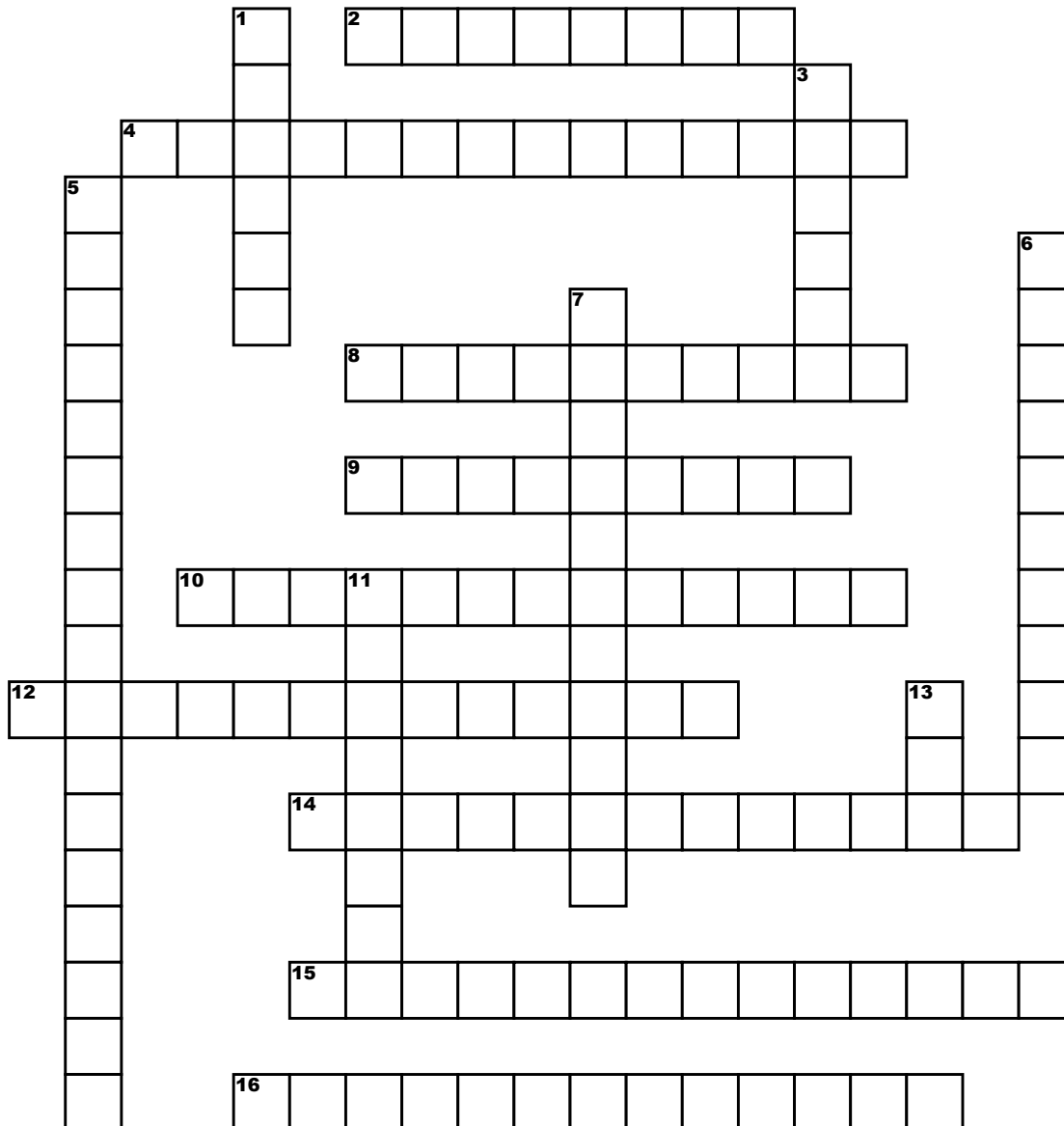


Chronic Disease

10. Type of diabetes where the body produces little or no insulin, considered an autoimmune disease.

12. A disease in which the body produces little or no insulin.

14. Disease where individual is hypersensitive to gluten, making it difficult to digest food.

15. A condition in which large amounts of abnormally thick mucus are produced, particularly in the lungs and pancreas.

16. A chronic inflammatory bowel disease that affects the lining of the digestive tract.

1. A condition caused by a blocked or broken blood vessel in the brain.

3. A group of diseases in which cells divide in an uncontrolled manner; these cells can form a tumor.

5. A genetic disease in which the muscles progressively deteriorate.

6. a progressive disease of the nervous system when individuals have tremors, muscular rigidity, and possibly very slow movements

7. The death of cardiac muscles caused by a lack of blood flow to the heart.

11. A disorder in which abnormal electrical activity in the brain causes a temporary loss of control of the mind and body.

13. A nervous system disease that weakens muscles and impacts physical function. Also called Lou Gehrig's disease.
