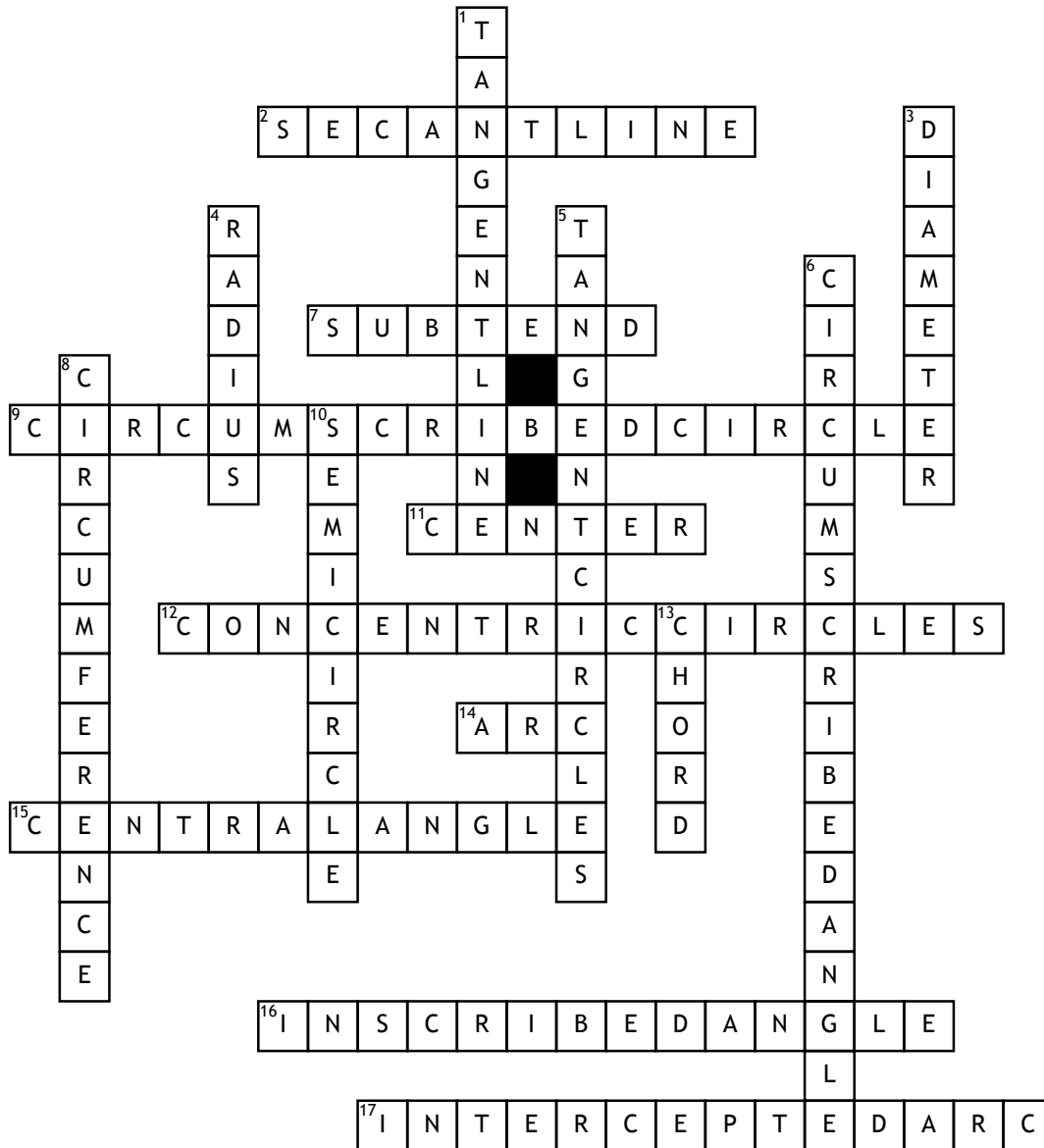


Circle Vocabulary

- 9. a circle that contains all the vertices of an inscribed polygon

- 12. coplanar circles that have a common center

 - 16. an angle whose vertex is on a circle and whose sides contain chords of the circle
