

- **3.** An arc whose lengths is less than half of the circle. Named with two points.
- **5.** The set of all points on a plane that a set distance from a given point (the center) in the plane.
- **6.** A line segment who endpoints are on the circle.
- **8.** The point where the tangent line intersects the circle.

- **9.** Two points on a circle and the continuous (unbroken) part of the circle between the two points.
- **10.** An angle whose vertex lies on the circle.
- 11. An angle whose vertex is the center of a circle and whose sides contain radii of the circle.
- **12.** A line that intersects the circle at a single point. It is always perpendicular to the radius.

- 1. A chord that contains the center of the circle. It is the longest chord of a circle.
- **2.** An arc of a circle whose length is more than half of the circle. Named with three points.
- **4.** An arc of a circle whose endpoints lie on a diameter.
- **7.** A line that intersects the circle in two points. It contains a chord.
