
Circulatory System

- **3.** Protein found in red blood cells that transports oxygen
- **5.** Largest artery in the body
- 7. Microscopic blood vessel which allows materials to diffuse in and out of blood
- **10.** Pressure of the blood flowing against artery walls when ventricle contracts

- **11.** Blood cell that transports oxygen, produced in bone marrow
- **12.** Blood cell that fights and destroys foreign agents
- **13.** Upper chambers which receive blood returning to the heart

<u>Down</u>

1. Vessel that moves blood toward the heart and away from the capillaries

- **2.** Helps blood to clot. Produced in bone marrow
- **4.** Lower chambers which pump blood out of the heart
- **6.** Prevents back flow in the heart
- **8.** Vessel that moves blood away from the heart toward capillaries
- **9.** Liquid portion of blood
