

- 7. Proper term for red blood cell
- 11. Upper chambers of the heart
- **12.** Returns blood to the heart, with thinner walls
- 13. The lower tip of the heart
- **14.** Carries oxygen rich blood out of the heart and to the body
- **15.** The right atrium receives blood from the systemic circuit through this large vein The higer up of a pair
- **16.** Tiny blood vessels between the smallest arteries and veins.
- **17.** Carries blood away from the heart, with thicker walls

- **18.** The right atrium receives blood from the systemic circuit through this large vein The lower of a pair
- **19.** Carries deoxygenated blood to the lungs

<u>Down</u>

- 1. Pair of chambers at the bottom of the heart pushes blood out to the arteries
- **2.** Valve which allows blood to flow from the atria to the ventricles
- **3.** Carries deoxygenated blood from the heart to the lungs and back. Right side of heart.

- **4.** Proper term for white blood cell
- **5.** Delivers oxygenated blood to cardiac muscle cells
- **6.** Valve that blood leaving the ventricles passes through, prevents back flow in the ventricle
- **8.** Delivers oxygenated blood to the left atrium
- **9.** Carries oxygenated blood out to the body tissues to supply oxygen and back. Left side of the heart.
- **10.** Proper term for a clotting cell; a platelet
