

- 3. a formal and organized process of electing or being elected, especially of members of a political body
- 5. a system of politics and government. It is usually compared to the legal system, economic system, cultural system, and other social systems
- 6. a party system where two major political parties dominate politics within a government
- 12. the aggregate of people living together in a more or less ordered community
- 13. an organised group of people with at least roughly similar political aims and opinions, that seeks to influence public policy by getting its candidates elected to public office
- 15. the governing body of a nation, state, or community

- 17. a quality or accomplishment that makes someone suitable for a particular job or activity
- 18. is a formal set of principal goals which are supported by a political party or individual candidate, in order to appeal to the general public, for the ultimate purpose of garnering the general public's support and votes about complicated topics or issues
