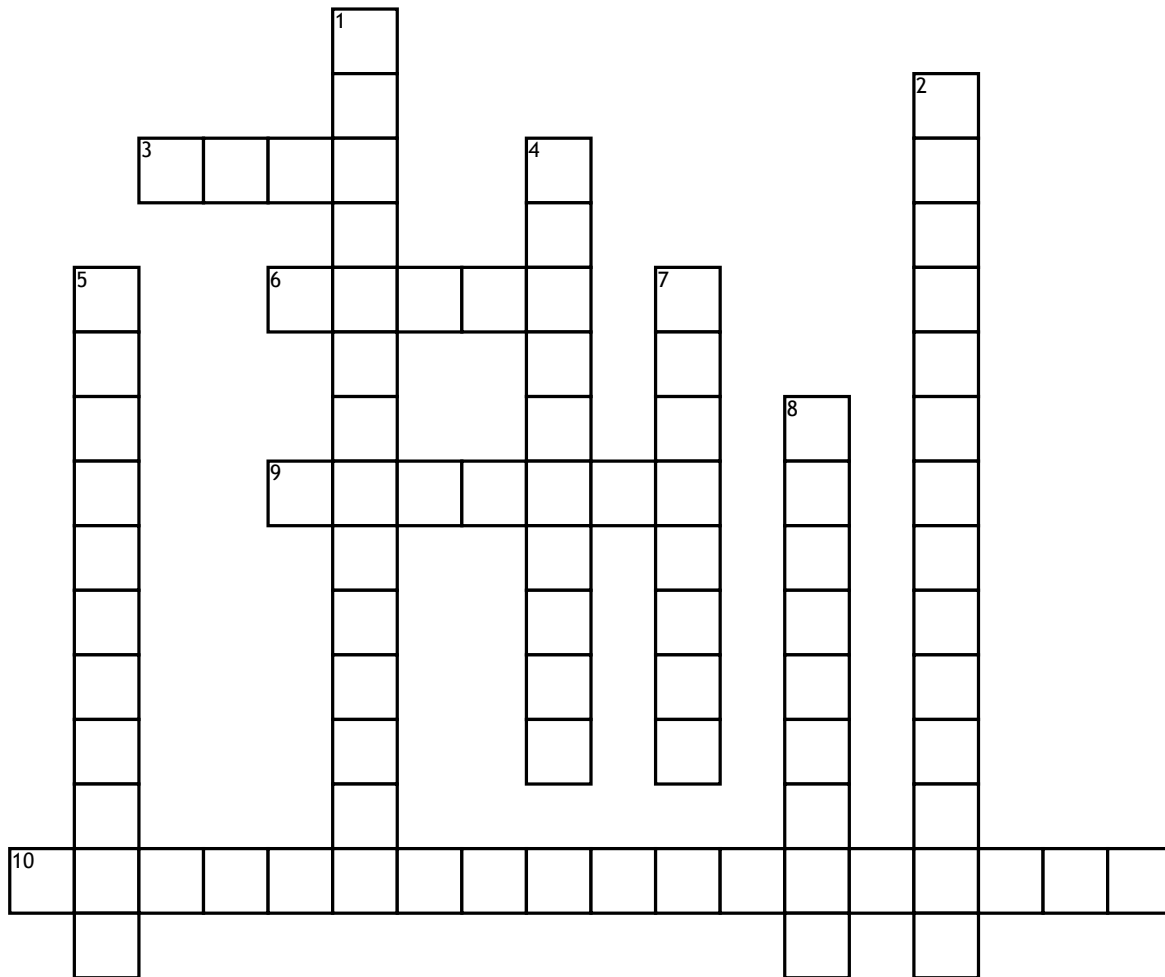


Civil Crossword
