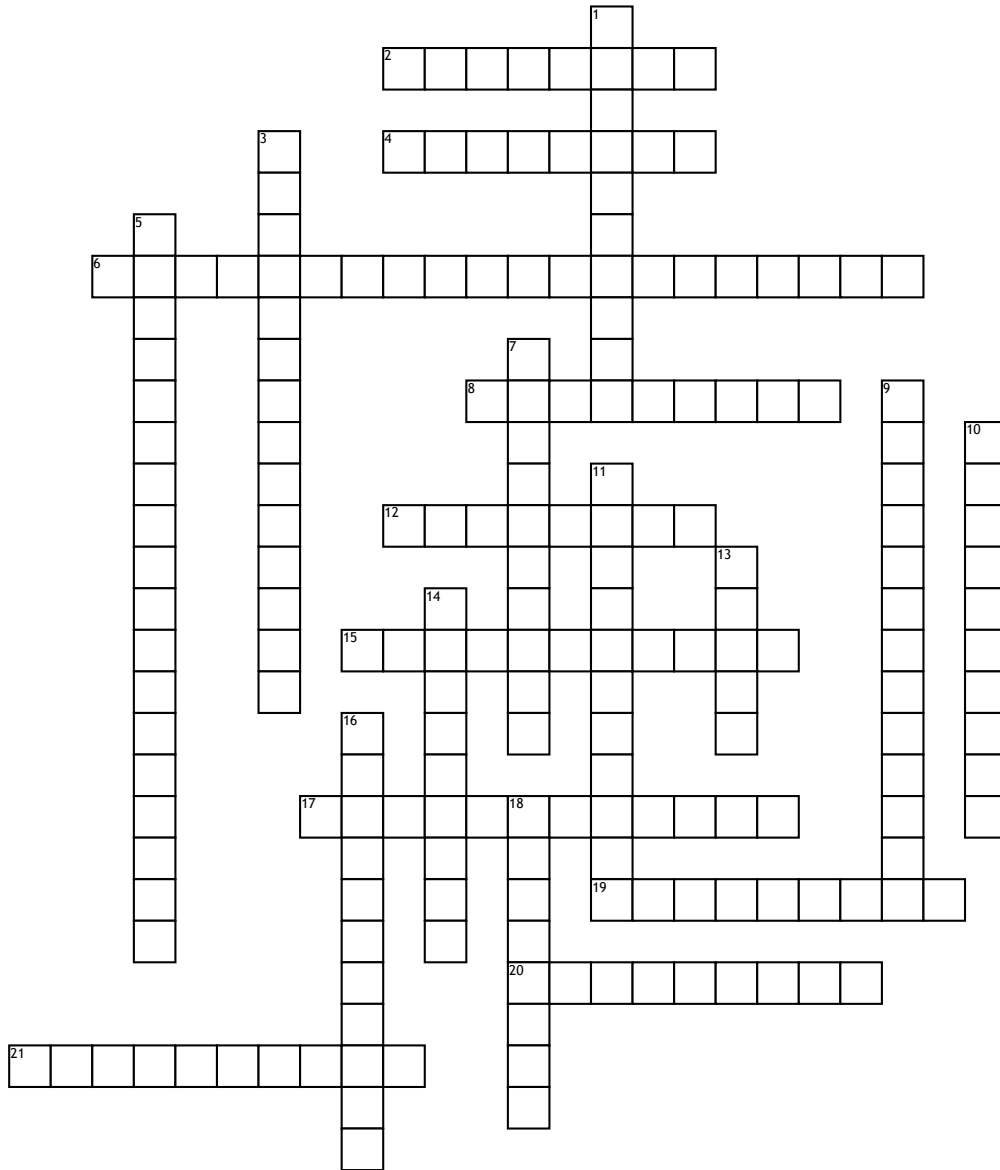

- 6. When John Brown and followers murdered 5 pro-slavery settlers in Kansas then mutilated their bodies to scare other slave supporters and to keep slavery supporters from moving into Kansas
- 8. The commander the Andersonville Prison
- 12. The organization dedicated to the medical care of the sick or wounded in wars and natural disasters
- 15. A Rights activist on behalf of mentally ill patients and created the first wave of US mental asylums
- 17. It was the Union's strategy to defeat the Confederacy

- 19. The withdrawal of the eleven Southern States from the Union in 1860
 - 20. This siege ended in the seizure of the Mississippi River by the Union
 - 21. The Antislavery political party that formed in the 1850's

- 1. The last fort in the south that belonged to the Union
 - 3. Served as the 16th president of the United States
 - 5. The belief that ultimate power resides in the people
 - 7. The party that support a decentralized government and state's rights
 - 9. The 1846 proposal that outlawed slavery in any territory gained from the War with Mexico

- 10. The Civil War's most famous battle because of its large size, high cost in lives, location in a northern state, and for President Abraham Lincoln's Address
- 11. People who opposed abolition and sympathized with the South during the Civil War
- 13. The Northern States plus the four Southern States that stayed with the United States
- 14. Who sued for freedom on the basis of his long residence on free soil. But ruling on the case was that he was a black slave and not a citizen, so he had no rights
- 16. Who seceded from the United States in 1861
- 18. A policy that protects the interests of native-born
