

- 3. refused Lincoln's offer to head the Union Army and agreed to lead Confederate forces; He successfully led several major battles until his defeat at Gettysburg; He surrendered to the Union's commander General Grant at Appomattox Courthouse
- **9.** Place where Civil War ended on April 9, 1865, when Lee surrendered to Grant
- **10.** Took Savannah and burned it to the ground; With 60,000 men, he began his celebrated "March to the Sea"

- **6.** A Union victory in the Civil War that marked the bloodiest single-day battle in U.S. military history
- 7. A speech given by Abraham Lincoln in which he praised the bravery of Union soldiers and renewed his commitment to winning the Civil War
- **8.** The first major battle of the American Civil War and was a Confederate victory
- 11. Founder of the American Red Cross; She obtained and administered supplies and care to the Union soldiers during the American Civil War
