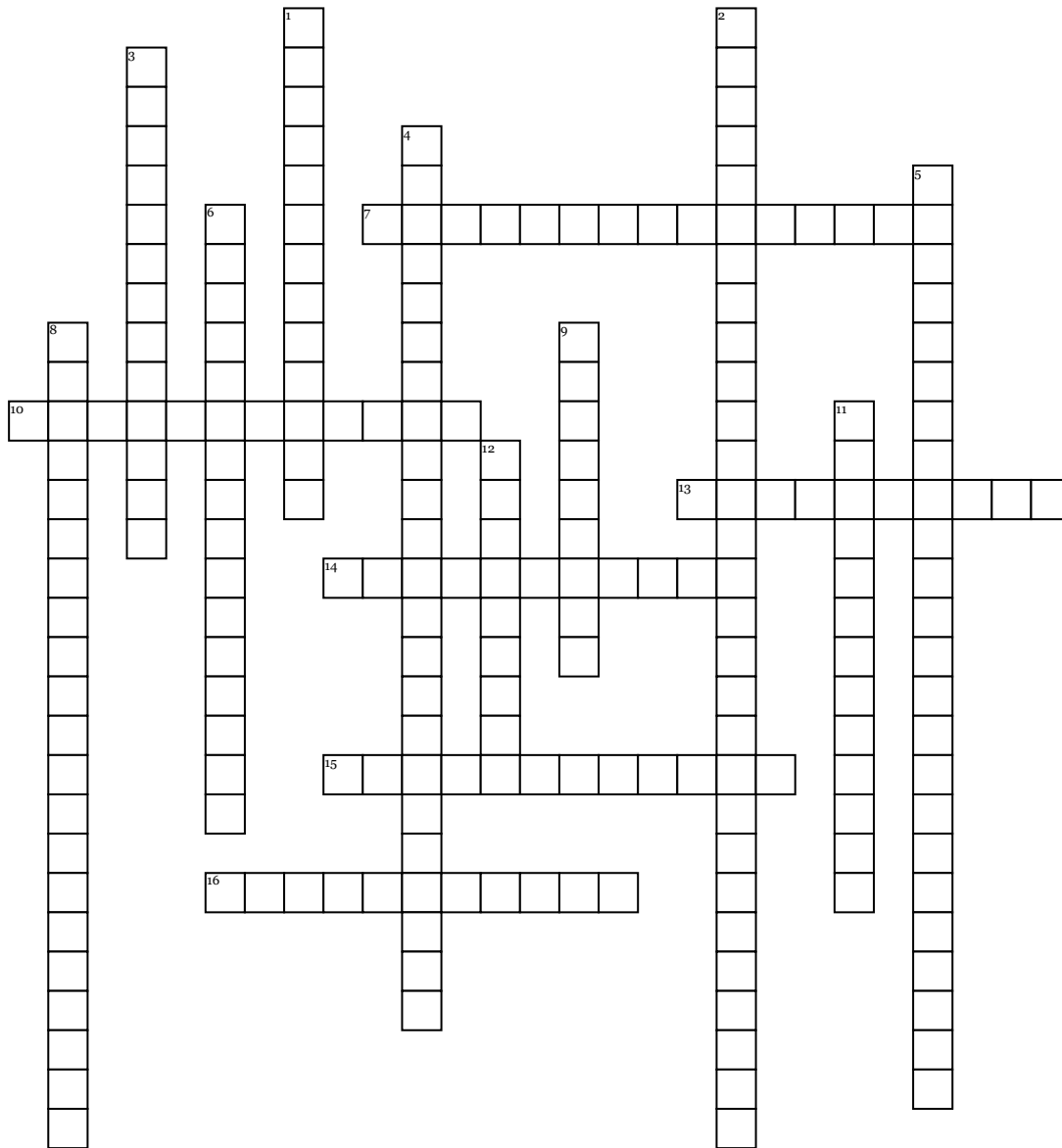


Civil War Crossword

- 7. a document created by Georgia to preserve the Union as long as the North abided by the Fugitive Slave Law
- 10. when a state takes notice to only the interests of that region alone
- 13. a state in which slavery was allowed
- 14. the rights that belonged to slaves
- 15. rights that states' believed gave them the final authority instead of the national government
- 16. 1863; biggest battle fought in Georgia; CSA soldiers gave back Union soldiers

Down

- 1. 1842; Union blocked ports of the CSA to keep them from exporting and importing
- 2. the election in which Republican, Abraham Lincoln was elected as president and resulted in the secession of South Carolina
- 3. the idea that states could deny federal laws in that state if they found the law "unconstitutional"
- 4. 1864; led by William T. Sherman; Chattanooga to Atlanta; resources were destroyed
- 5. a document legalized during Lincoln's presidential term that freed all slaves in the confederacy

- 6. a compromise devised by the national government to preserve the union by giving incentives to the North and South
- 8. 1864; William T. Sherman led soldiers from Atlanta to Savannah; along the way they destroyed any resources or supplies
- 9. a "right" of the people and state to leave a nation or country and example is South Carolina's act in 1860
- 11. a case taken to the U.S. Supreme Court where a slave had sued the state of Missouri for his freedom
- 12. a state in which slavery was prohibited
