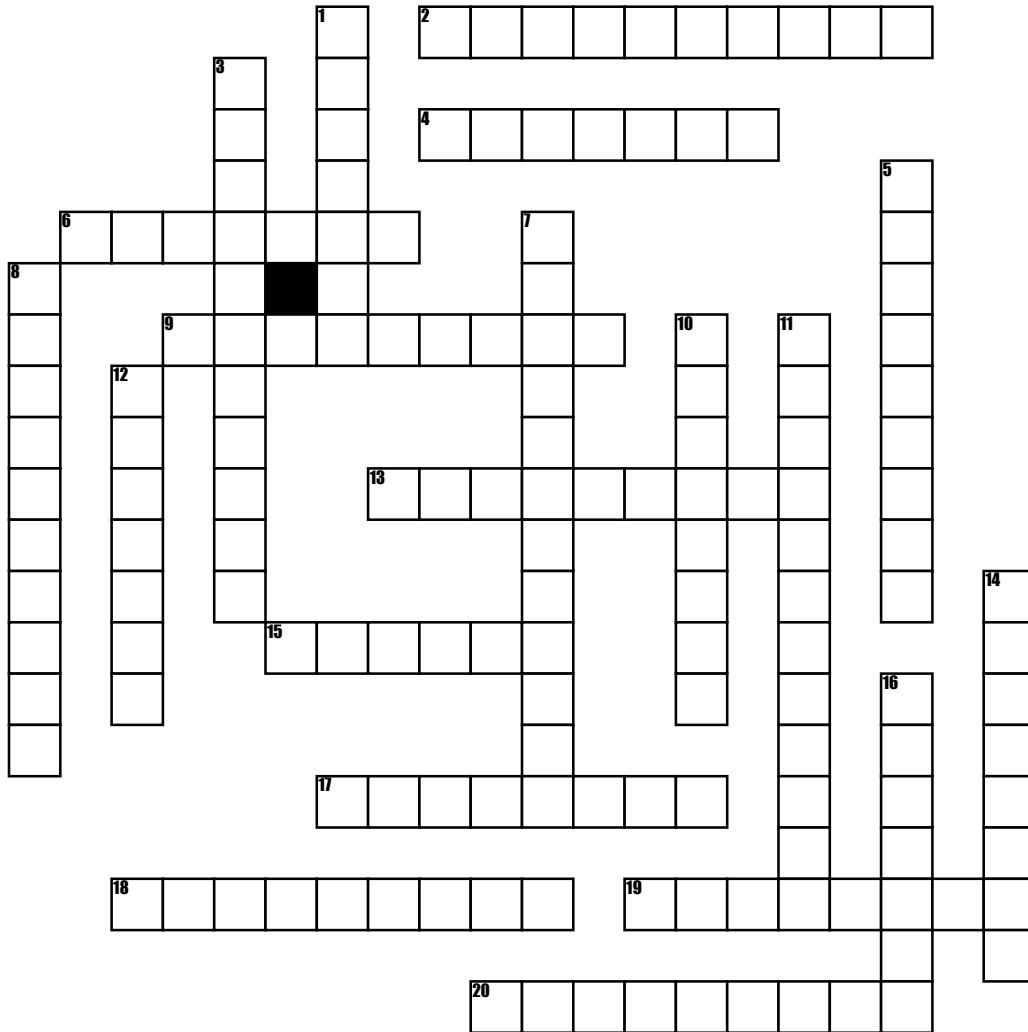


Civil War Crossword Puzzle
