

- 1. Famous as the site of the surrender of the Confederate Army under Robert E. Lee to Union commander Ulysses S. Grant
- ratified after the Civil War that forbade slavery and involuntary servitude.
- 4. Issued by Abraham Lincoln on September 22, 1862 it declared that all slaves in the confederate states would be free
- 5. U.S. Union Army outline strategy for suppressing the Confederacy at the beginning of the American Civil

- 6. Confederate general who had opposed secession but did not believe the Union should be held together by
- 7. an American general and the eighteenth President of the United States (1869-1877). He achieved international fame as the leading Union general in the American Civil War.
- 9. 1863 Union army's blockade of Vicksburg, Mississippi, that led the city to surrender during the Civil War
