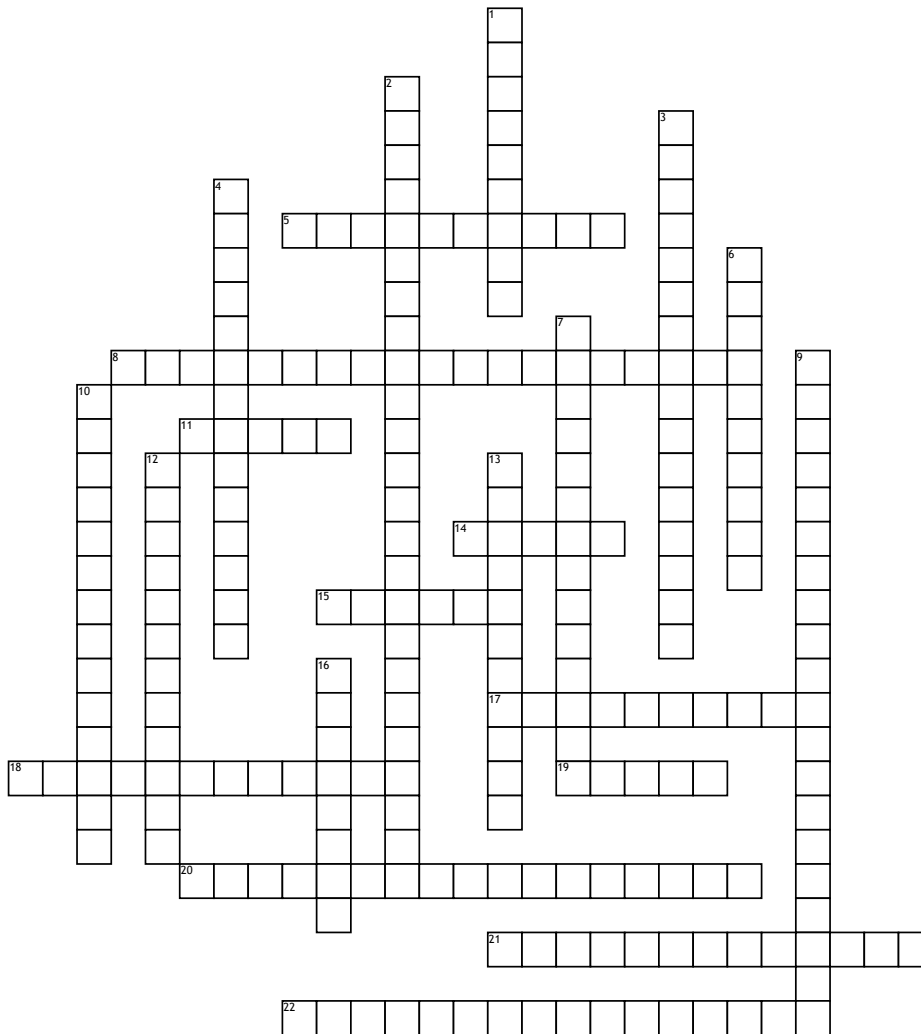


# Civil War
