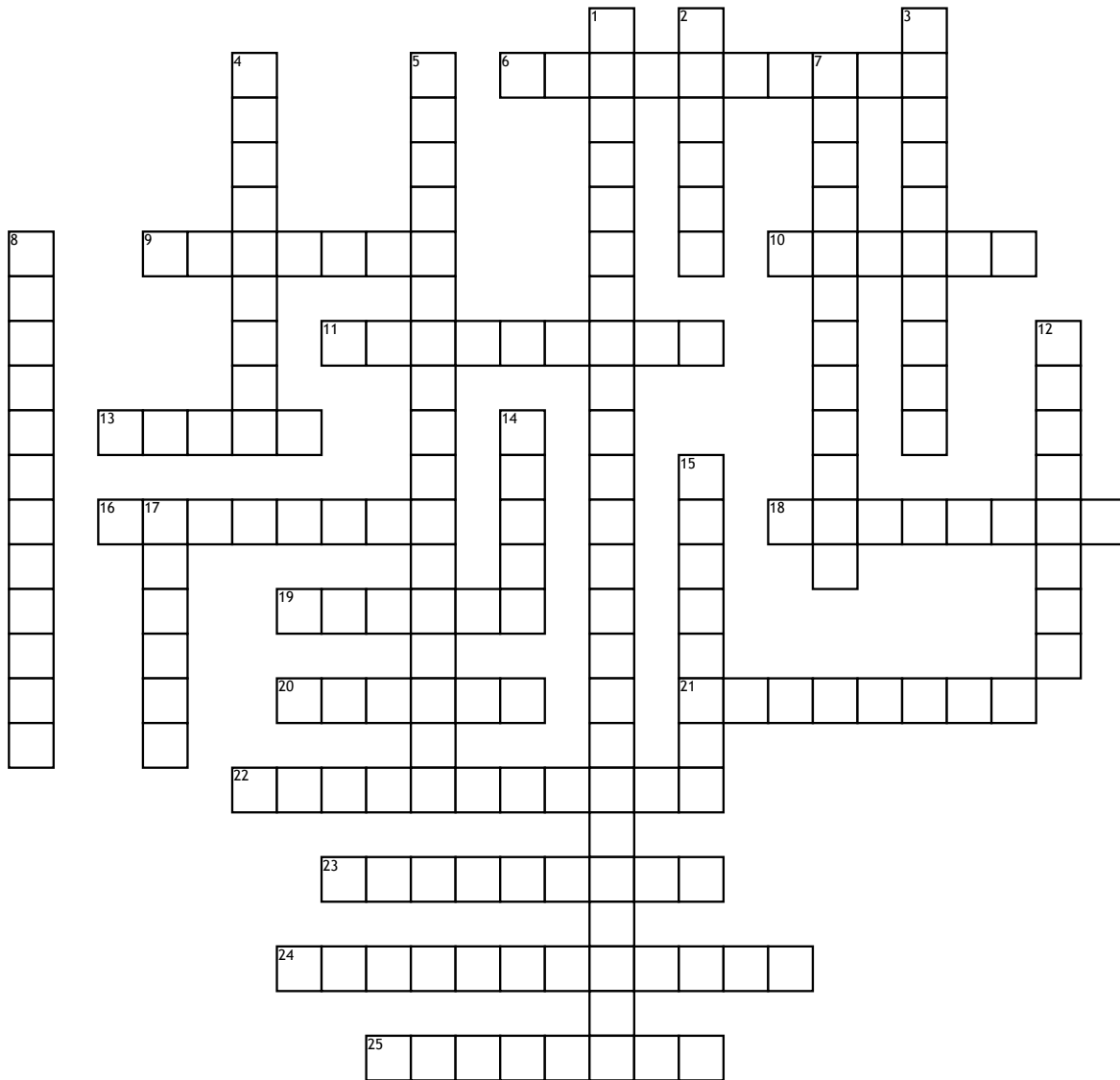


Civil War crossword puzzle
