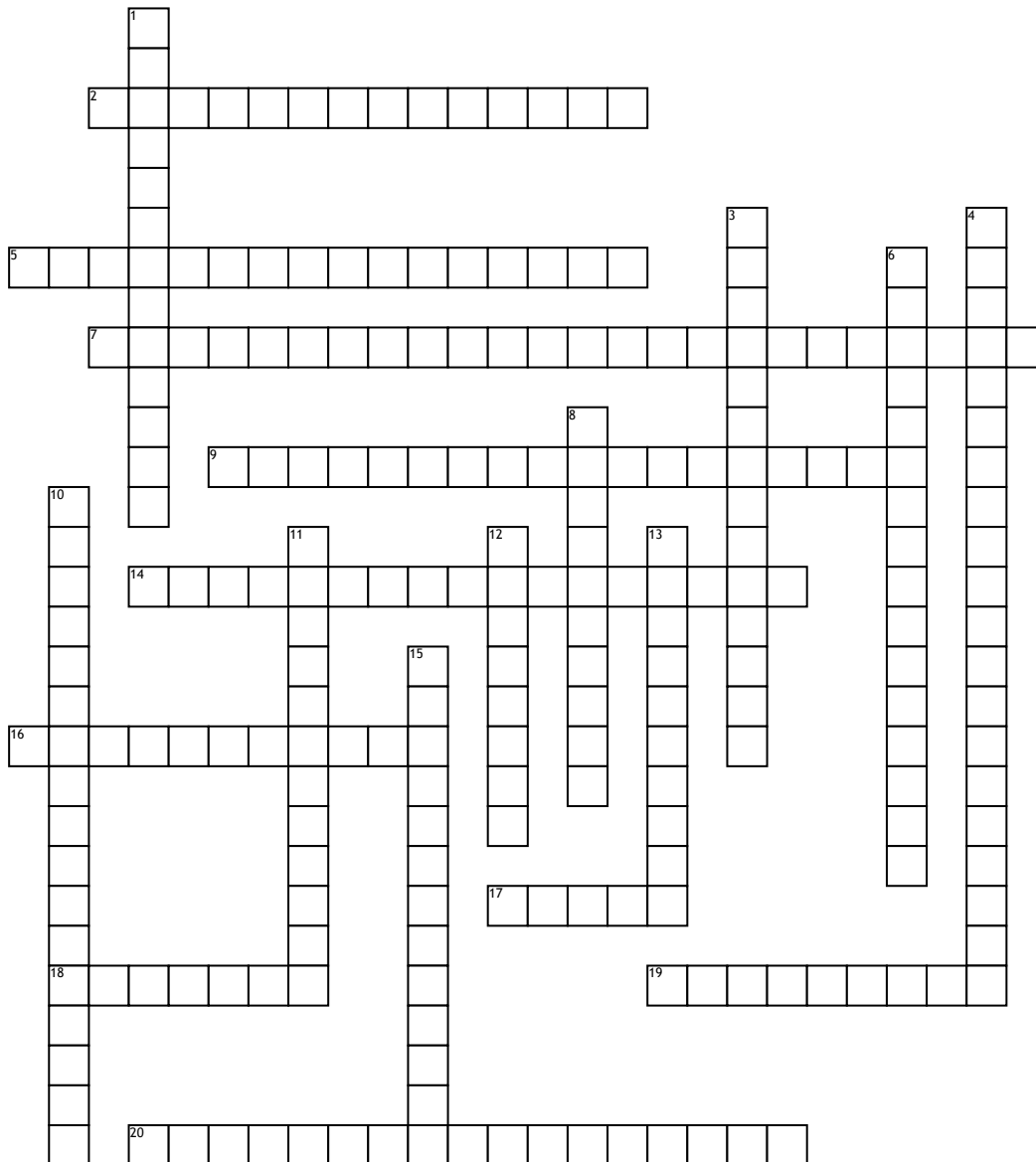

2. President of the Confederacy; born in Kentucky; for slavery; believed states had the right to leave the Union
5. General for the South; got his nickname because he refused to retreat during battle
7. Document freeing slaves in Union-controlled Confederate states
9. A series of agreements passed by Congress in 1820-1821 to maintain the balance of power between slave states and free states
14. A law that allowed voters in Kansas and Nebraska to choose whether to allow slavery or not.
16. The southern states that seceded from the United States in 1861.

17. the United States (especially the northern states during the American Civil War)

18. Condition of being owned by, and forced to work for someone else.

19. Device that allowed messages to be sent by wires over long distances

20. U.S. Supreme Court decision which determined that slaves (Dred Scott) could not sue in federal court because they did not have the rights of citizenship.

4. Place where Civil War ended on April 9, 1865, when Lee surrendered to Grant.

8. Union military post in South Carolina which was taken over by the Confederacy in 1861.

10. The fall of Vicksburg, Mississippi, to General Ulysses S. Grant's army on July 4th, 1863, after 48 days of siege.

11. Place in Virginia where John Brown led a raid on a federal arsenal.

13. Rapid-fire gun capable of shooting 600 rounds per minute.

15. Successful Union general who attended West Point Military Academy; against slavery
