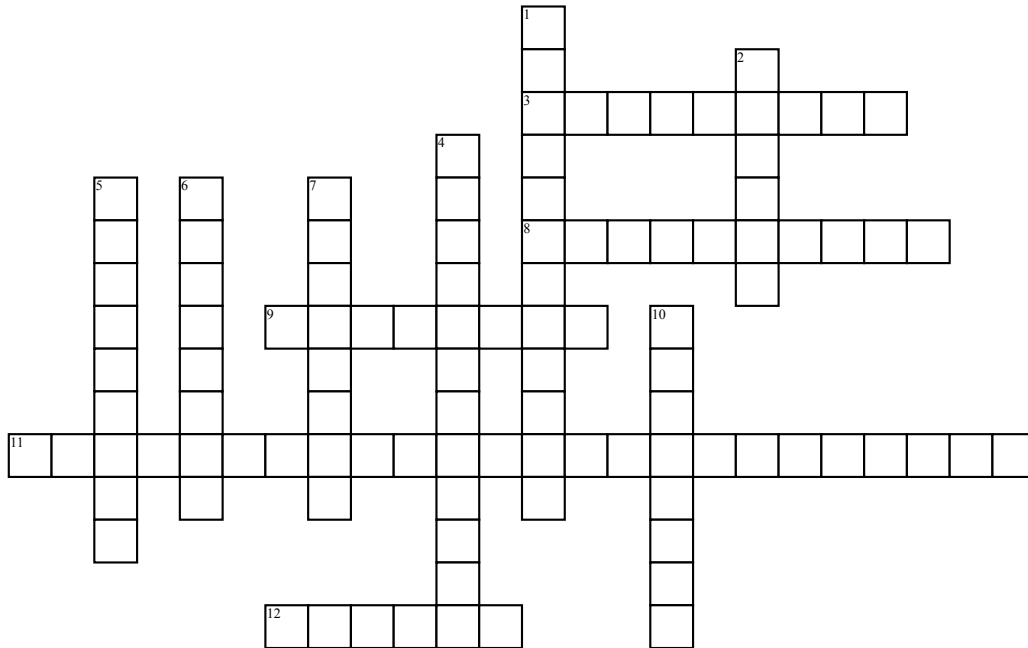

- 1. state on the border between the North and South: Delaware, Maryland, Kentucky, and Missouri
- 2. reward or payment
- 4. a legal writ, or order, that guarantees a prisoner the right to be heard in court

5. stream or smaller river that feeds into a larger river

- 6. to place within a trench, or ditch, for defense; to place in a strong defensive position
- 7. a strategy of bringing war to the entire society, not just the military
- 10. a warship equipped with iron plating for protection
